

Getting Started:

- · Gather any additional materials needed.
- Trim all zip strips and set aside. The zip strip is the ½" accent paper along the top of each sheet of patterned paper.
- Check the cut orientation below each cutting guide image. This will show you how to cut the paper, keeping the patterns on your project pieces facing the right direction.
- Light grey pieces on your cutting guide are project pieces. White pieces are leftover paper.
- · As you cut the paper, sort the pieces as indicated in the cutting guide, creating a stack for each project.

 \Re = first cut | * = use back of paper paper | P = project cut diagonal = angle in trimmer

Project 1: Left Page








- 1. Use polka-dot Glacier paper for base page
- 2. Draw a light guideline with pencil, 1½" from top
- 3. Attach floral Sapphire paper triangle in upper left corner, as shown
- 4. Attach remaining triangle papers and die-cuts, as shown
- 5. Attach stitched White Daisy square die-cuts, as shown
- 6. Erase pencil line
- 7. Attach photo mat with 3-D foam tape
- 8. Attach photo
- 9. Add journaling
- 10. Embellish with remaining die-cuts and stickers, as shown *Tip: Attach a few of these pieces with 3-D foam tape for added dimension.*
- 11. Embellish with wood buttons

 Tips: Color the wood pieces with marker before attaching, if desired. Attach with glue dots.

Project 1: Right Page







- 1. Use polka-dot Glacier paper for base page
- 2. Draw a light guideline with pencil, 1½" from top
- 3. Attach floral Sapphire paper triangle in upper left corner, as shown
- 4. Attach remaining triangle papers and die-cuts, as shown
- 5. Attach stitched White Daisy square die-cuts, as shown
- 6. Erase pencil line

- 4. Attach photos
- 5. Embellish with remaining die-cuts and stickers, as shown *Tip: Attach a few of these pieces with 3-D foam tape for added dimension.*
- 6. Embellish with wood buttons







- 1. Use denim paper for base page
- 2. Attach quilt paper triangles, as shown
 Tip: Use a 3" × 3" photo placeholder as an easy guide. Lay the
 photo placeholder down in the corners of your page and attach
 the triangles around it, first. Remove the photo placeholder and
 attach the remaining pieces.
- 3. Attach photo mats with 3-D foam tape
- 4. Attach photos

- 5. Layer and attach scalloped oval sticker to oval journaling die-cut
- 6. Add journaling to die-cut and attach with 3-D foam tape
- 7. Embellish with remaining die-cuts and stickers, as shown *Tip: attach a few of these pieces with 3-D foam tape for added dimension.*
- 8. Embellish with wood buttons
 Tips: Color the wood pieces with marker before attaching, if
 desired. Attach with glue dots.








- 1. Use White Daisy cardstock for base page

- 6. Attach photos


