Additional Materials Needed:

- Z3630 Watercolor Pencils (optional)
- Z3515 Black Journaling Pen (.01)
- Z1151 3-D Foam Tape
- Scissors
- Ruler
- Pencil

Gather photos (18 total)

(P) = portrait (L) = landscape

Getting Started:

- Gather any additional materials needed.
- Trim all zip strips and set aside. The zip strip is the ½" accent paper along the top of each sheet of patterned paper.
- Check the cut orientation below each cutting guide image. This will show you how to cut the paper, keeping the patterns on your project pieces facing the right direction.
- Light grey pieces on your cutting guide are project pieces. White pieces are leftover paper.
- As you cut the paper, label and sort the pieces as indicated in the cutting guide, creating a stack for each project.

Key:

✂ = first cut | * = use back of paper paper
cut diagonal = angle in trimmer

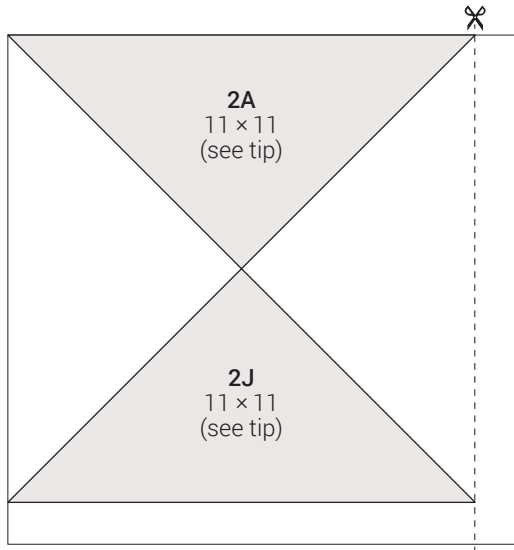

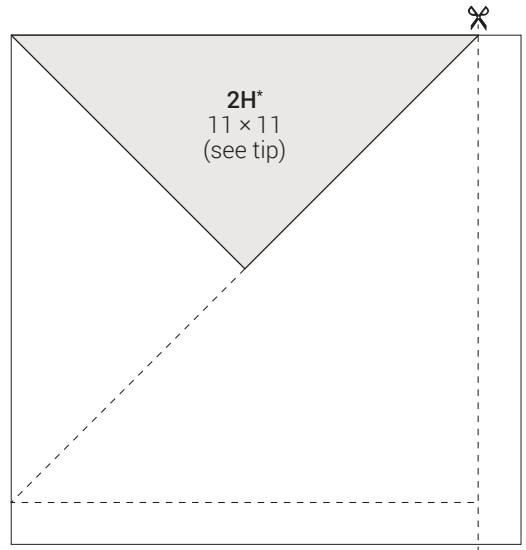

Tip: Cut the 11" x 11" square first. Then, draw a light diagonal line with a pencil and ruler, from one corner to another. Use this guideline to cut the square in half using scissors (it will not fit in a standard size paper trimmer). Cut the two triangles you just created down the middle to make 2A and 2J, as shown.

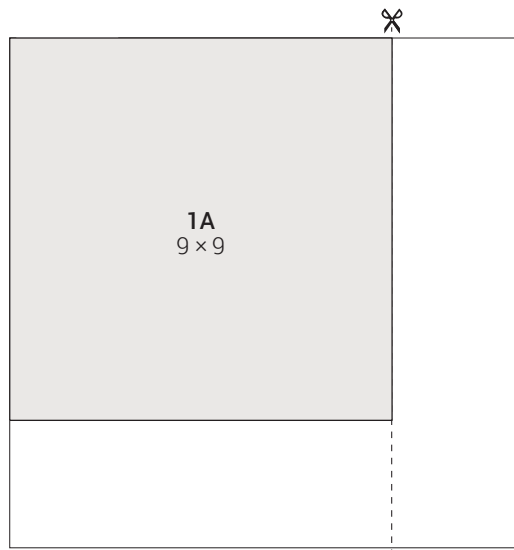

Tip: Cut the 11" x 11" square first. Then, draw a light diagonal line with a pencil and ruler, from one corner to another. Use this guideline to cut the square in half using scissors (it will not fit in a standard size paper trimmer). Cut the top triangle you just created down the middle to make 2H, as shown.



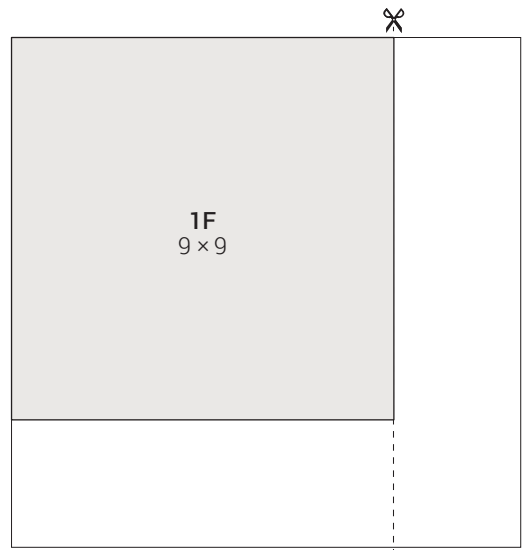

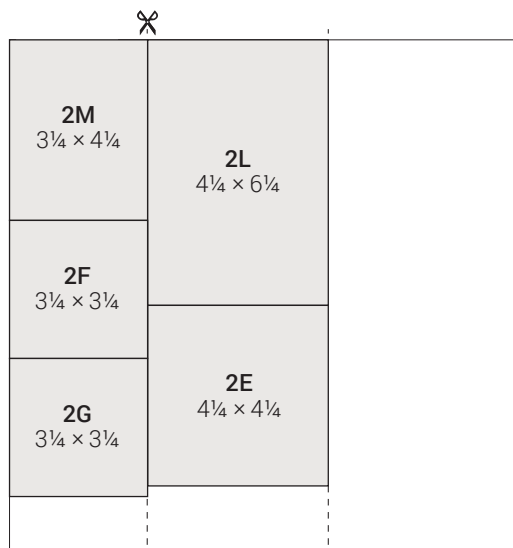
Tip: Before cutting, draw a light diagonal line from the provided tick marks to the corners of the paper, as shown, with a pencil and ruler. Then, cut the two large patterned triangles using scissors (it will not fit in a standard size paper trimmer). Use the pencil line as a guide to cut these two triangles down the middle on your trimmer to make 2B, 2K, 2C, and 2I, as shown.



Exclusive Paper



Tip: Before cutting, draw a light diagonal line from the provided tick mark to the corner of the paper, as shown, with a pencil and ruler. Then, cut the large gingham patterned triangle using scissors (it will not fit in a standard size paper trimmer). Use the pencil line as a guide to cut this triangle down the middle on your trimmer to make 2D, as shown. Cut 1I out of the remaining paper, as shown.



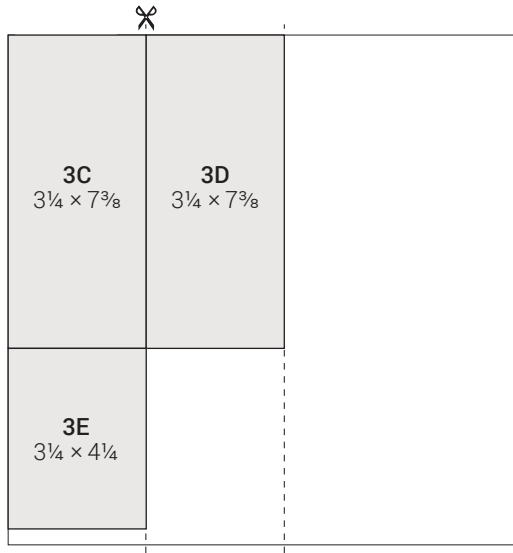

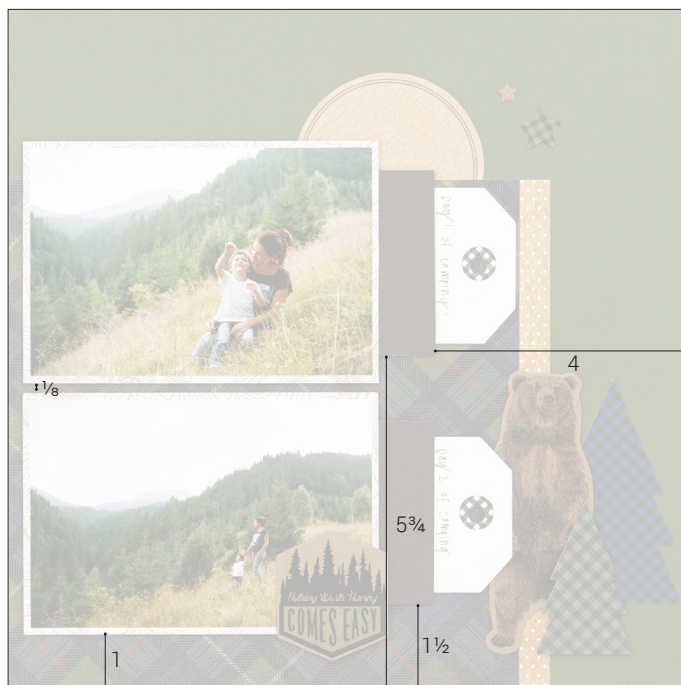
Project 1: Left Page



Assemble:

1. Use New England Ivy cardstock for base page
2. Attach 1A and 1B
3. Attach 1C, 1D, and 1E with 3-D foam tape
4. Attach photos
5. Attach title stickers, as shown
6. Attach tree and circle die-cuts, as shown
Tip: Attach a few of these pieces with 3-D foam tape for added dimension.
7. Embellish with star chipboard die-cuts and file tab sticker, as shown
8. (Optional) Add color to chipboard die-cuts with watercolor pencils
9. Add date

Project 1: Right Page



Assemble:

1. Use New England Ivy cardstock for base page
2. Attach 1F and 1G
Tip: Do not use adhesive along the top right edge of 1F so another piece can be tucked behind it in step 3.
3. Tuck large circle die-cut slightly under 1F, as shown
4. Fold pocket die-cuts and attach
5. Attach 1H and 1I with 3-D foam tape
6. Attach photos
7. Embellish with die-cuts and chipboard die-cuts, as shown
Tip: Attach a few of these pieces with 3-D foam tape for added dimension.
8. (Optional) Add color to chipboard die-cuts with watercolor pencils
9. Add journaling to tags and slide into pockets

Project 2: Left Page



Assemble:

1. Use White Daisy cardstock for base page
2. Attach 2A, 2B, 2C, and 2D
3. Attach 2E
4. Attach 4" x 4" photo
5. Attach 2F and 2G with 3-D foam tape
Tip: Do not use adhesive along the top of 2F so other pieces can be tucked behind it in a later step.
6. Attach 3" x 3" photos
7. Attach large wooden arrow die-cut, as shown
8. Attach title sticker and red banner sticker
9. Embellish with remaining die-cuts and stickers, as shown
Tip: Tuck two banner die-cuts slightly behind 2F, as shown.
10. Attach chipboard die-cut arrow with 3-D foam tape
11. (Optional) Add color to chipboard die-cuts with watercolor pencils

Project 2: Right Page



Assemble:

1. Use White Daisy cardstock for base page
2. Attach 2H, 2I, 2J, and 2K
3. Attach saw blade die-cut, as shown
4. Attach 2L
5. Attach kraft zig zag die-cut border under 2L
6. Attach 4" x 6" photo
7. Attach playing card sticker, as shown
8. Attach 2M with 3-D foam tape
9. Attach remaining photo
10. Embellish with remaining die-cuts, chipboard die-cuts, and stickers, as shown
Tip: Attach a few of these pieces with 3-D foam tape for added dimension.
11. (Optional) Add color to chipboard die-cuts with watercolor pencils
12. Add journaling

Project 3: Left Page



Assemble:

1. Use wood grain paper for base page
2. Attach hexagon pieces and photos to back of large overlay die-cut, as shown
3. Attach overlay die-cut to base page
4. Attach remaining hexagon die-cuts, as shown
Tip: Attach black hexagon with 3-D foam tape.
5. Attach die-cut title with 3-D foam tape
6. Embellish with chipboard die-cuts and stickers, as shown
Tip: Attach a few of these pieces with 3-D foam tape for added dimension.
7. (Optional) Add color to chipboard die-cuts with watercolor pencils
8. Dovetail and attach 3A

Project 3: Right Page



Assemble:

1. Use wood grain paper for base page
2. Attach 3B
3. Attach 3C, 3D, and 3E
4. Attach photos, as shown
5. Embellish with die-cuts, as shown
Tip: Attach a few of these pieces with 3-D foam tape for added dimension.
6. Attach "All I need..." chipboard die-cut with 3-D foam tape
7. Embellish with stickers, as shown
Tip: Attach mountainscape sticker with 3-D foam tape.
8. (Optional) Add color to chipboard die-cut with watercolor pencils
9. Add journaling
