- Z2829 Espresso Exclusive Inks™ Stamp Pad (optional)
- Z3515 Black Journaling Pen (.01)
- Z2089 Glue Dots® Micro Dots
- Z2060 Thin 3-D Foam Tape
- Y1000 1" x 1" My Acrylix® Block (optional)
- Y1003 2" x 2" My Acrylix® Block (optional)
- Y1005 1" x 6½" My Acrylix® Block (optional)

Getting Started:

- Gather any additional materials needed.
- Trim all zip strips and set aside. The zip strip is the ½" accent paper along the top of each sheet of patterned paper.
- Check the cut orientation below each cutting guide image. This will show you how to cut the paper, keeping the patterns on your project pieces facing the right direction.
- Light grey pieces on your cutting guide are project pieces. White pieces are leftover paper.
- As you cut the paper, label and sort the pieces as indicated in the cutting guide, creating a stack for each project.

✂ = first cut | * = use back of paper paper | P = project
cut diagonal = angle in trimmer

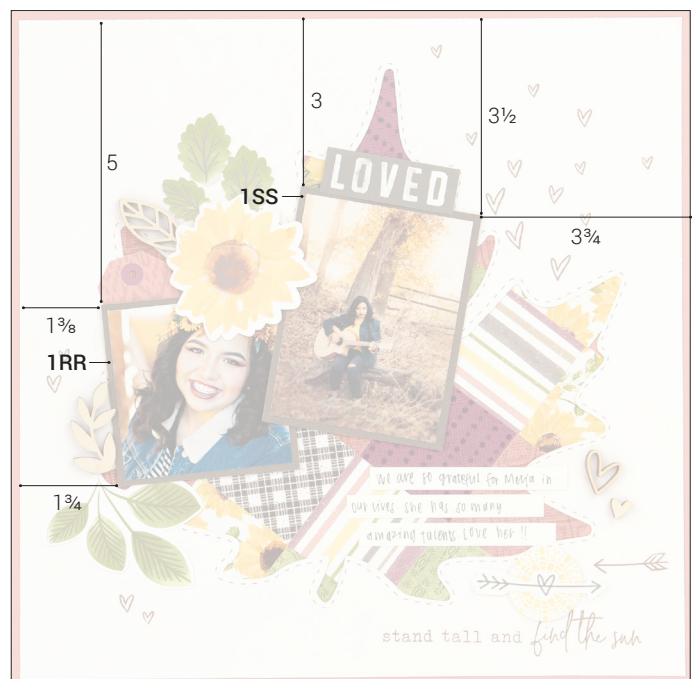
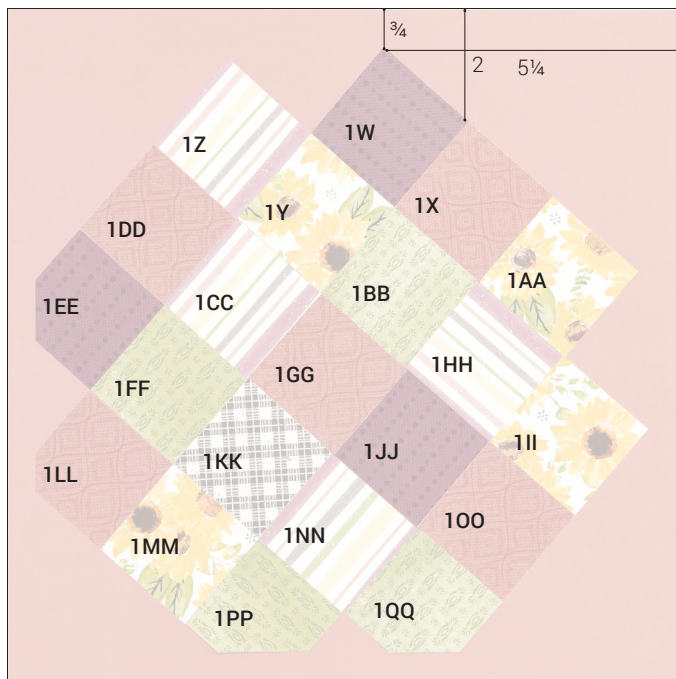
Project 1: Left Page



Assemble:

1. Use Desert Rose cardstock for base page
2. Attach 1B and 1C to 1A
3. Attach 1D through 1R to 1A and build background
Tips: After attaching, trim excess off 1P, 1Q, and 1R. Keep pieces that you trim off in case you need any of them to fill in on the right page.
4. Attach 1A to base page
5. Dovetail and attach 1S
6. Attach large sunflower cluster sticker, as shown
7. Attach 1T, 1U, and 1V with thin 3-D foam tape
8. Attach photos
9. Attach "SHINE" title stickers
10. Embellish with additional stickers and die-cuts, as shown
11. Embellish with wood shapes
Tip: Attach with glue dots.
12. (Optional) Stamp hearts with Espresso ink, as shown

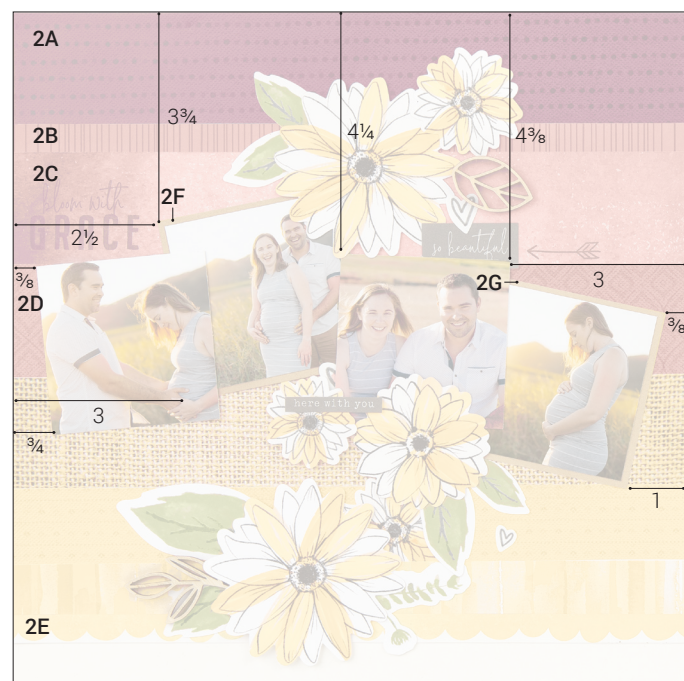
Project 1: Right Page



Assemble:

1. Use Desert Rose cardstock for base page
2. Attach 1W through 1QQ to base page and build background
Tips: Trim $\frac{1}{2}$ " off the side tips of 1EE and 1LL, and $\frac{1}{2}$ " off the bottom tips of 1PP and 1QQ before attaching.
3. Attach large leaf overlay die-cut, as shown
Tip: If there are areas that need filling in before attaching the overlay, use the leftover pieces you saved from the left page.
4. Attach 1RR
5. Attach 3" x 3" photo
6. Attach 1SS
7. Attach 3" x 4" photo
8. Embellish with stickers, die-cuts, and wood shapes, as shown
Tips: Attach a few of these pieces with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension. Attach wood shapes with glue dots.
9. Add journaling
10. (Optional) Stamp arrow, sentiment, and hearts with Espresso ink, as shown

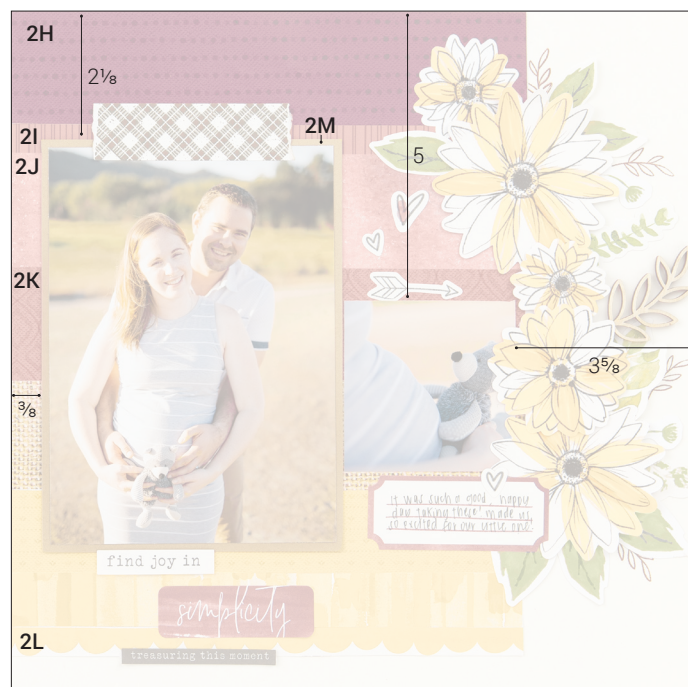
Project 2: Left Page



Assemble:

1. Use French Vanilla cardstock for base page
2. Attach 2A, 2B, 2C, and 2D
3. Attach burlap die-cut strip, Sundance print die-cut strip, and Sundance watercolor die-cut strip, as shown
4. Attach 2E, 2F, and 2G
5. Attach photos
6. Embellish with stickers, remaining die-cuts, and wood shapes, as shown
Tips: Attach a few of these pieces with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.
7. Embellish with wood shapes
Tip: Attach with glue dots.
8. (Optional) Stamp sentiment and arrow with Espresso ink, as shown

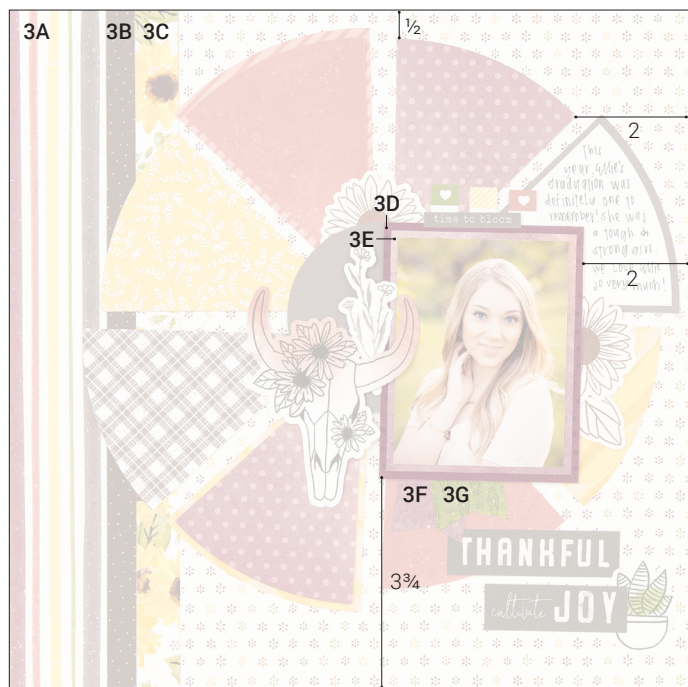
Project 2: Right Page



Assemble:

1. Use French Vanilla cardstock for base page
2. Attach 2H, 2I, 2J, and 2K
3. Attach burlap die-cut strip, Sundance print die-cut strip, and Sundance watercolor die-cut strip, as shown
4. Attach 2L and 2M
5. Attach photos
6. Tear ends of 2N and attach, as shown
7. Embellish with stickers, remaining die-cuts, and wood shapes as shown.
Tips: Attach a few of these pieces with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension. Attach wood shapes with glue dots.
8. (Optional) Stamp sprigs with Espresso ink, as shown
9. Add journaling

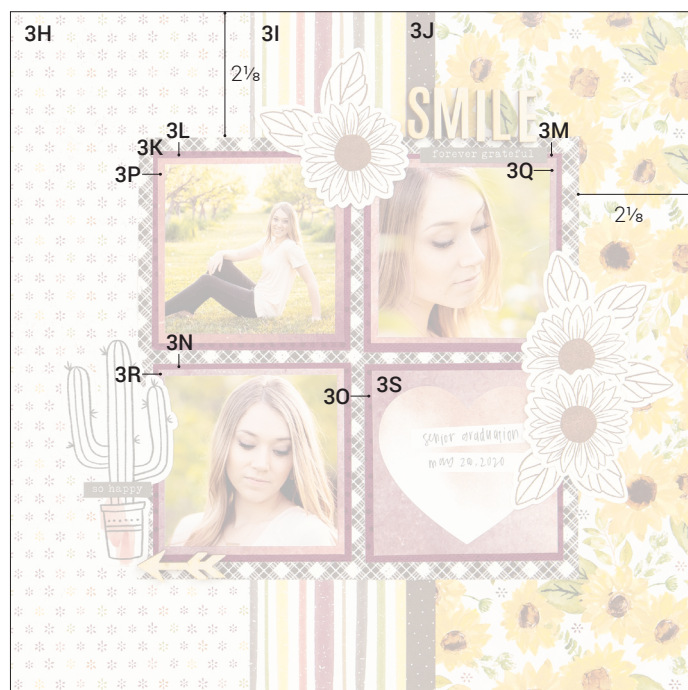
Project 3: Left Page



Assemble:

1. Use small floral paper for base page
2. Attach 3A, 3B, and 3C
3. Build and attach circle wedge die-cuts as shown
4. Attach 3D and 3E
Tip: Do not use adhesive along the bottom of 3D so other pieces can be tucked behind it in a later step.
5. Dovetail and attach 3F and 3G
Tip: Tuck slightly behind 3D, as shown.
6. Attach photo
7. Embellish with stickers and remaining die-cuts, as shown
8. Add journaling
9. (Optional) Die-cut and stamp sunflowers and leaf with Espresso ink, then use to embellish, as shown

Project 3: Right Page



Assemble:

1. Use sunflower paper for base page
2. Attach 3H, 3I, and 3J
3. Attach 3K
4. Attach 3L, 3M, 3N, and 3O
5. Attach 3P, 3Q, 3R, and 3S
6. Attach photos
7. Embellish with stickers and wood shapes, as shown
Tip: Attach wood shapes with glue dots.
8. Add journaling
9. (Optional) Die-cut and stamp sunflowers and leaves with Espresso ink, then use to embellish, as shown
