- G1223 Sweet Safari Scrapbooking Workshop Kit
- Z3819 Cheddar Gloss Spray (optional)
- Z3823 Turquoise Gloss Spray (optional)
- Z3515 Black Journaling Pen (.01)
- Z2060 Thin 3-D Foam Tape
- Z1836 Non-stick Micro-tip Scissors
- Adhesive
- Trimmer

Getting Started:

- Gather all materials needed.
- Trim all zip strips and set aside. The zip strip is the ½" accent paper along the top of each sheet of patterned paper.
- Check the cut orientation below each cutting guide image. This will show you how to cut the paper, keeping the patterns on your project pieces facing the right direction.
- Light grey pieces on your cutting guide are project pieces. White pieces are leftover paper.
- As you cut the paper, label and sort the pieces as indicated in the cutting guide, creating a stack for each project.

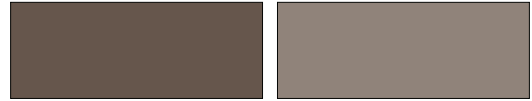

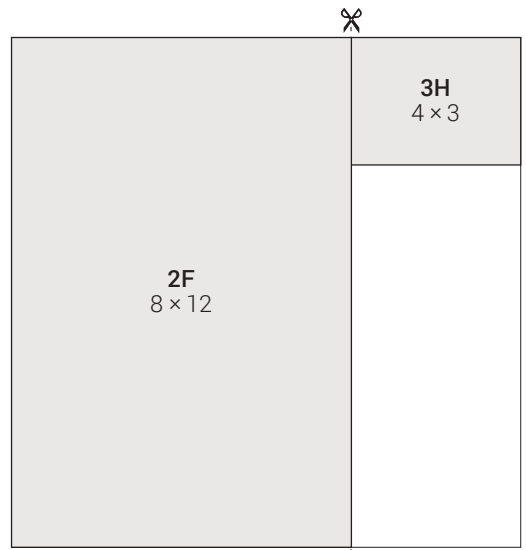


Lagoon cardstock

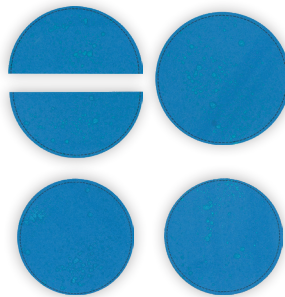


Project 1: Left Page

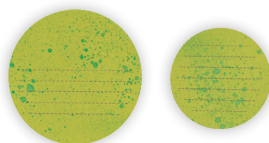


(Optional) Prepare for both pages:

Note: Spray pieces in an area you don't mind getting messy. Gloss sprays stain.



Paper: Bluebird circle die-cuts
Media: Turquoise Gloss Spray
Tip: Spray die-cuts from approx. 6 inches.



Paper: Avocado journaling die-cuts
Media: Turquoise Gloss Spray
Tip: Spray die-cuts from approx. 6 inches.



Paper: Sundance leaf die-cuts
Media: Cheddar Gloss Spray
Tip: Spray die-cuts from approx. 6 inches.



Assemble:

1. Prepare pieces shown above
2. Use animal paper for base page
3. Attach 1A
4. Attach circle die-cuts, as shown
Tip: Only use adhesive on the centers of the die-cuts so other pieces can be tucked behind them in a later step.
5. Attach photos to back of circle die-cut frames and trim off excess
6. Attach framed photos with thin 3-D foam tape
7. Attach leaf die-cuts and stickers, as shown
Tips: Tuck some leaves slightly behind circle die-cuts. Attach a few of these pieces with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.
8. Attach title sticker with thin 3-D foam tape
9. Embellish with additional stickers, as shown
Tip: Attach a few stickers with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.
10. Add extra adhesive to circle die-cuts, if desired
11. Embellish with puffy stickers
12. Add journaling

Project 1: Right Page



Assemble:

1. Use animal paper for base page
2. Attach 1B
3. Attach circle die-cuts, as shown
Tip: Only use adhesive on the centers of the circle die-cuts so other pieces can be tucked behind them in a later step.
4. Attach photos to back of circle die-cut frames and trim off excess
5. Attach framed photos with thin 3-D foam tape
6. Attach leaf die-cuts and stickers, as shown
Tips: Tuck some leaves slightly behind circle die-cuts. Attach a few of these pieces with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.
7. Embellish with remaining stickers, as shown
Tip: Attach a few stickers with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.
8. Add extra adhesive to circle die-cuts, if desired
9. Embellish with puffy stickers
10. Add journaling

Media: Turquoise Gloss Spray
Tip: Spray die-cuts from approx. 6 inches.



Die-cut:

Tip: Spray die-cuts from approx. 6 inches.



Assemble:

1. Prepare pieces shown above
2. Use Candy Apple dot paper for base page
3. Attach 2A
4. Attach "let's the day away" die-cut
5. Attach 2B and 2C
6. Attach scallop die-cut
7. Attach 2D and 2E with thin 3-D foam tape
8. Attach photos
9. Attach rainbow and "p-l-a-y" stickers, as shown
Tip: Attach the "l" sticker first to help with the placement of the rainbow and the remaining letter stickers.
10. Embellish with additional die-cuts and stickers, as shown
Tip: Attach a few of these pieces with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.
11. Embellish with puffy stickers

Project 2: Right Page



Assemble:

1. Use Candy Apple dot paper for base page
2. Attach 2F, 2G, and 2H
3. Attach scallop die-cut
4. Attach 2I, 2J, and 2K with thin 3-D foam tape
5. Attach photos
6. Attach journaling sticker, as shown
7. Embellish with remaining die-cuts and stickers, as shown
Tip: Attach a few of these pieces with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.
8. Embellish with puffy stickers
9. Add journaling

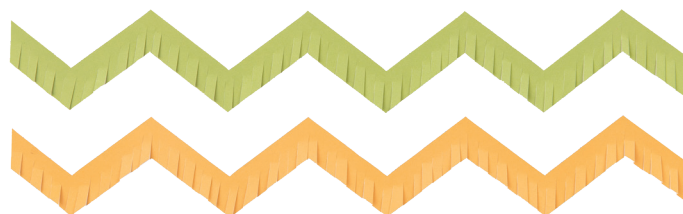

Paper: Avocado and Sundance chevron die-cuts

Media: Cheddar Gloss Spray

Tips: Spray die-cuts from approx. 6 inches. Use scissors to cut fringe.



Paper: Avocado and Sundance chevron die-cuts

Tip: Use scissors to cut fringe.



Assemble:

1. Prepare pieces shown above
2. Use leaf paper for base page
3. Attach 3A
4. Attach chevron die-cuts
Tips: Begin building with bottom chevron and work up. Attach the fringed die-cuts last, overlapping them on top of other chevron strips, as shown.
5. Attach 3B and 3C with thin 3-D foam tape
6. Attach photos
7. Attach title sticker with thin 3-D foam tape
Tip: Do not use adhesive along the left edge of the "A" so other pieces can be tucked behind it in a later step.
8. Embellish with additional stickers, as shown
Tips: Tuck leaf stickers slightly behind the title sticker. Attach a few of these pieces with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.
9. Embellish with puffy stickers

Project 3: Right Page



Assemble:

1. Use leaf paper for base page
2. Attach 3D
3. Attach chevron die-cuts
Tips: Begin building with bottom chevron and work up. Attach the fringed die-cuts last, overlapping them on top of other chevron strips, as shown.
4. Attach 3E, 3F, 3G, and 3H with thin 3-D foam tape
5. Attach photos
6. Draw border around 3H with journaling pen
7. Embellish with remaining die-cuts and stickers, as shown
Tips: Attach a few of these pieces with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension. Attach the alligator sticker after embellishing with puffy stickers.
8. Embellish with puffy stickers
9. Add journaling
