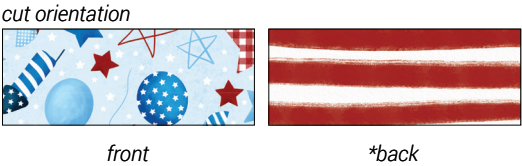
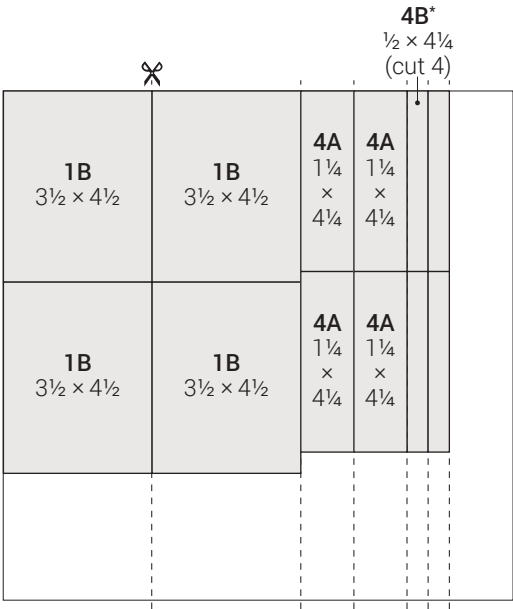
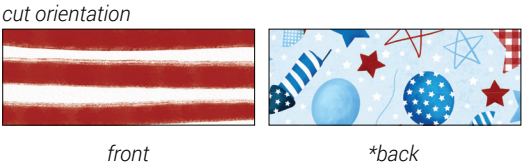
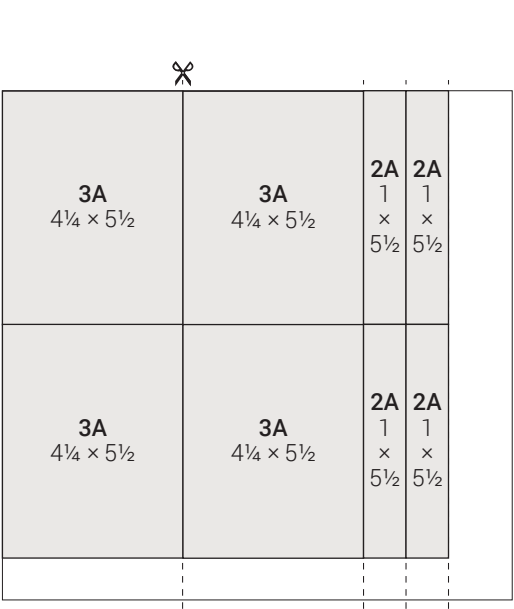
Getting Started:

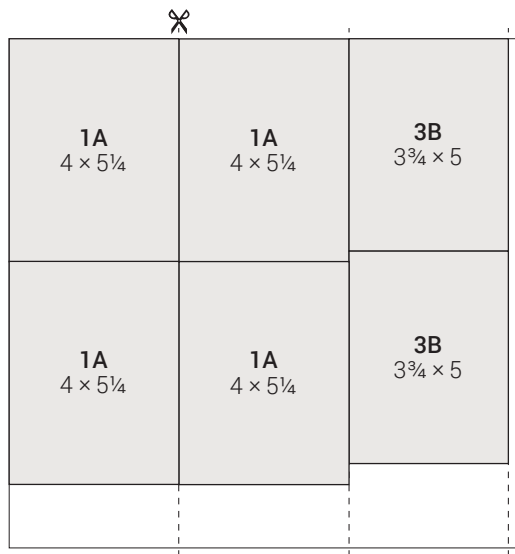
- Gather all materials needed.
- Trim all zip strips and set aside. The zip strip is the ½" accent paper along the top of each sheet of patterned paper.
- Light grey pieces on your cutting guide are project pieces. White pieces are leftover paper.
- As you cut your paper, label and sort the pieces as indicated in the cutting guide, creating a stack for each project.
- If there is a fold line present in a cutting diagram, cut the paper first before folding it. In order to die-cut two shapes at once, place the die on top of the folded paper or stack two paper pieces before running the paper through your die-cutting machine. Paper pieces that can be stacked for die-cutting will be labeled, "stack."

- = fold line
- = suggested Thin Cuts arrangement

Project 1: Make 4

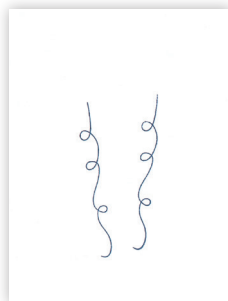


Prepare (4 each):



P1 Accents:

Paper: White Daisy
Dies: balloons
Inks: Bluebird, Carolina, Scarlet



1C:

Paper: White Daisy
Ink: Sapphire
Tips: Lay the prepared balloon accents on 1C, without attaching, to determine where to stamp the curly strings. Remove the accents before stamping.



P1 Accents:

Paper: White Daisy
Die: bow
Inks: Bluebird, Scarlet



P1 Accent:

Paper: White Daisy
Die: sentiment string
Ink: Scarlet



Assemble:

1. Prepare pieces shown above
2. Attach 1A and 1B
3. Attach 1C with thin 3-D foam tape
4. Attach balloon and bow accents with thin 3-D foam, as shown
5. Attach sentiment string accent with thin 3-D foam tape, as shown
6. Embellish with glitter die-cuts
Tip: Attach with glue dots.

Project 2: Make 4



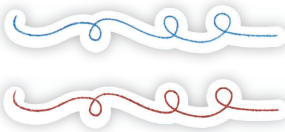

Card Base:
Paper: White Daisy
Ink: Carolina



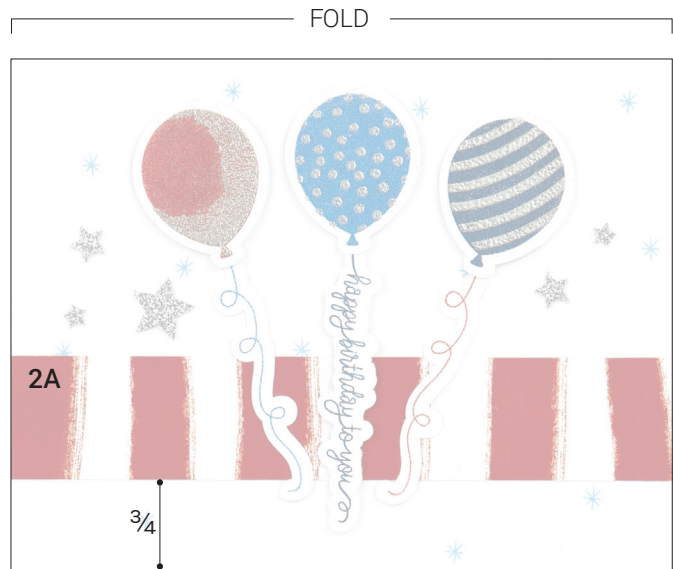
P2 Accents:
Paper: White Daisy
Dies: balloons
Inks: Bluebird, Sapphire, Scarlet, VersaMark™
Tip: Heat emboss the shadow, dots, and stripes once the colored ink is dry.
Technique: First, rub the balloons with the anti-static pouch. Then, emboss the image by stamping with VersaMark™ ink, sprinkling the wet image with embossing powder, shaking off any excess powder, and heating with the heat tool until the powder and ink melt together.



P2 Accents:
Paper: White Daisy
Die: curly string
Inks: Bluebird, Scarlet



P2 Accent:
Paper: White Daisy
Die: sentiment string
Ink: Sapphire



Assemble:

1. Prepare pieces shown above
2. Attach 2A
3. Attach prepared accents, as shown
Tip: Attach a few of these pieces with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.
4. Embellish with glitter die-cuts
Tip: Attach with glue dots.

Project 3: Make 4



Prepare (4 each):



P3 Accents:

Paper: White Daisy

Dies: balloons

Inks: Bluebird, Carolina, Scarlet, VersaMark™

Tip: Heat emboss stripes and dots once the colored ink is dry.

Technique: First, rub the balloons with the anti-static pouch. Then, emboss the image by stamping with VersaMark™ ink, sprinkling the wet image with embossing powder, shaking off any excess powder, and heating with the heat tool until the powder and ink melt together.



3C:

Paper: White Daisy

Inks: Sapphire, Scarlet

Tips: Stamp the sentiment first.

Then, lay the prepared balloon accents on 3C, without attaching, to determine where to stamp the strings. Remove the accents before stamping.



P3 Accents:

Paper: White Daisy

Die: tassel

Ink: VersaMark™

Tips: Heat emboss. Make 4 per card.
Technique: First, rub the die-cuts with the anti-static pouch. Then, emboss the image by stamping with VersaMark™ ink, sprinkling the wet image with embossing powder, shaking off any excess powder, and heating with the heat tool until the powder and ink melt together.

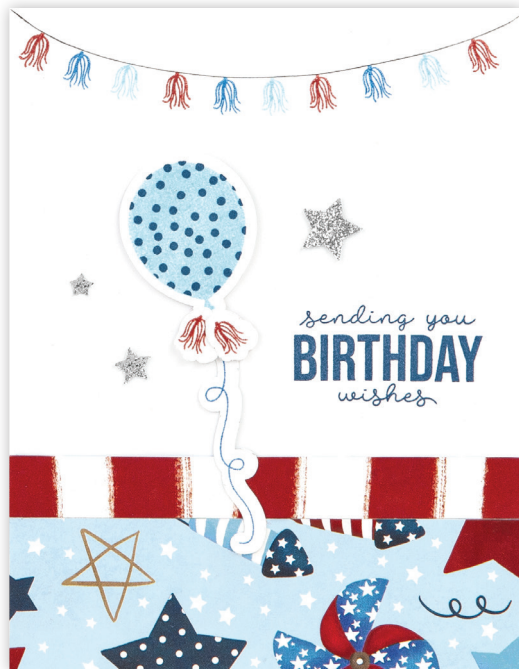
FOLD



Assemble:

1. Prepare pieces shown above
2. Attach 3A and 3B
3. Attach 3C with thin 3-D foam tape
Tip: Attach a few of these pieces with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.
4. Attach prepared accents, as shown
Tip: Attach with glue dots.

Project 4: Make 4

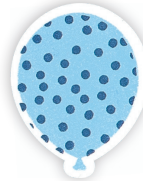


Prepare (4 each):



Card Base:

Paper: White Daisy
Inks: Bluebird, Carolina, Scarlet
Tip: First, draw a line for the hanging tassel banner with a journaling pen. Then, stamp the tassels, as shown.



P4 Accent:

Paper: White Daisy
Die: balloon
Inks: Carolina, Sapphire



P4 Accent:

Paper: White Daisy
Die: curly string
Ink: Bluebird



P4 Accent:

Paper: White Daisy
Die: tassel
Ink: Scarlet
Tip: Make 2 per card.



Assemble:

1. Prepare pieces shown above
2. Attach 4A and 4B
3. Stamp sentiment with Sapphire ink, as shown
Tip: Attach a few of these pieces with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.
4. Attach prepared accents, as shown
Tip: Attach with glue dots.
5. Embellish with glitter die-cuts
Tip: Attach with glue dots.
