Getting Started:

- Gather all materials needed.
- Trim all zip strips and set aside. The zip strip is the ½" accent paper along the top of each sheet of patterned paper.
- Check the cut orientation below each cutting guide image. This will show you how to cut the paper, keeping the patterns on your project pieces facing the right direction.
- Light grey pieces on your cutting guide are project pieces. White pieces are leftover paper.
- As you cut the paper, label and sort the pieces as indicated in the cutting guide, creating a stack for each project.

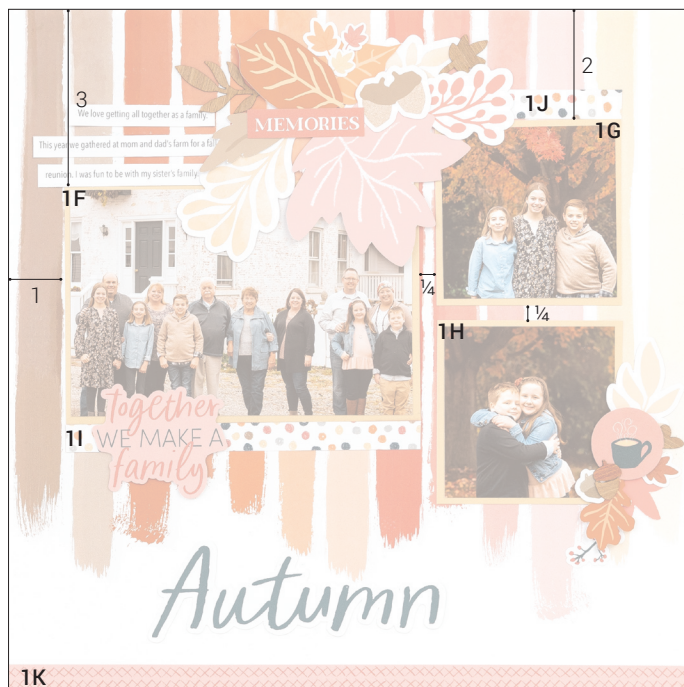
Project 1: Left Page



Assemble:

1. Use exclusive paint swash paper for base page
Tip: Make sure to use the paper with the swashes that match those shown on this page.
2. Attach 1A and 1B
Tip: Do not use adhesive along the bottom right corner of 1A so another piece can be tucked behind it in a later step.
3. Attach photo to 1A
4. Attach 1C with thin 3-D foam tape
5. Attach photo to 1C
6. Attach 1D and 1E
7. (Optional) Color wood stickers with darkest Gold Yellow blend marker, as shown
Tip: Keep the stickers on their backing sheet while coloring them.
8. Embellish with stickers, wood stickers, and die-cuts, as shown
Tips: Attach a few of these pieces with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension. Tuck the Shortbread leaves die-cut slightly behind 1A.
Note: Depending on where you live, we have provided two options in the die-cuts for the words "favorite/favourite" and "color/colour."

Project 1: Right Page



Assemble:

1. Use exclusive paint swash paper for base page
Tip: Make sure to use the paper with the swashes that match those shown on this page.
2. Attach 1F, 1G, and 1H
Tip: Do not use adhesive along the bottom right corner of 1H so other pieces can be tucked behind it in a later step.
3. Attach photos
4. Attach 1I, 1J, and 1K
5. Attach journaling strips, as shown
6. (Optional) Color wood stickers with darkest Gold Yellow blend marker, as shown
Tip: Keep the stickers on their backing sheet while coloring them.
7. Embellish with stickers, wood stickers, and die-cuts, as shown
Tips: Attach a few of these pieces with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension. Tuck the Papaya leaf die-cut and sprig sticker slightly behind 1H.
8. Add journaling

Project 2: Left Page



(Optional) Prepare for Both Pages:

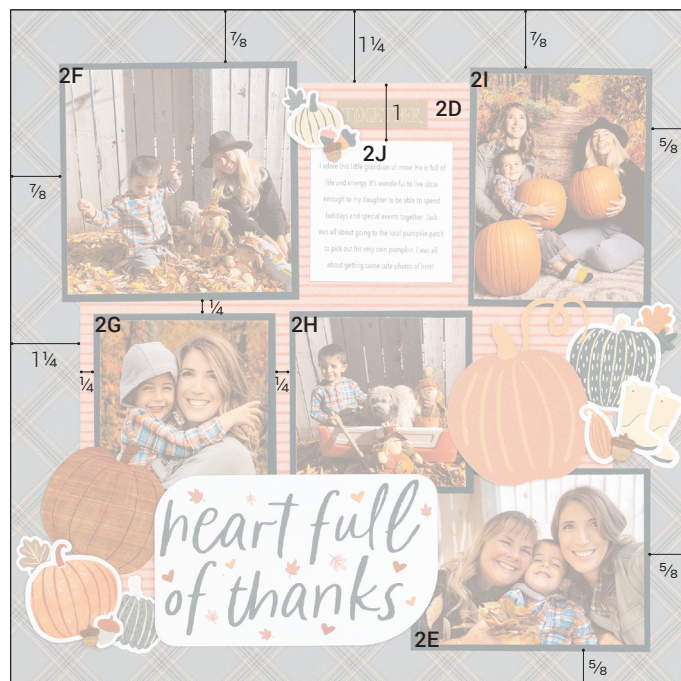
- Assemble the two large pumpkin die-cuts, as shown
Tips: Attach photos to the back side of the largest pumpkin, trimming where needed.
- Layer the small pumpkin and stem die-cuts, as shown



Assemble:

1. Use plaid patterned paper for base page
2. Attach 2A and 2B
Tip: Do not use adhesive along the top right of 2A so other pieces can be tucked behind it in a later step.
3. Attach large pumpkin die-cuts, as shown
Tip: Do not use adhesive along the top of these so other pieces can be tucked behind them in a later step.
4. Attach 2C
Tip: Do not use adhesive along the top so another piece can be tucked behind it in a later step.
5. Attach photo to 2C
6. (Optional) Color wood stickers with all Gold Yellow blends and darkest True Blue blend markers, as shown
Tips: Keep the stickers on their backing sheet while coloring them.
7. Embellish with stickers, wood stickers, and additional die-cuts, as shown
Tips: Attach the layered stem die-cuts to the large pumpkins, as shown. Tuck the green stem slightly behind 2C. Tuck two banner stickers slightly under the top right of 2A, as shown. Tuck the large leaf and vine die-cuts slightly behind the top of the largest pumpkin die-cuts, as shown.

Project 2: Right Page



Assemble:

1. Use plaid patterned paper for base page
2. Attach 2D
3. Attach 2E
4. Attach photo to 2E
5. Attach 2F, 2G, 2H, and 2I
6. Attach remaining photos
7. Attach large title sticker with thin 3-D foam tape, as shown
Tip: Do not use adhesive along the left edge so other pieces can be tucked behind it in a later step.
8. Add journaling to 2J and attach
9. (Optional) Color wood stickers with darkest Coral blend, darkest True Blue blend, and all Gold Yellow blend markers
Tips: For the hearts, layer the lightest and middle Gold Yellow and darkest Coral blend markers to create the color shown. Keep the stickers on their backing sheet while coloring them.
10. Embellish with additional stickers, wood stickers, and die-cuts, as shown
Tips: Attach a few of these pieces with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension. Tuck some of these pieces slightly behind the title sticker.

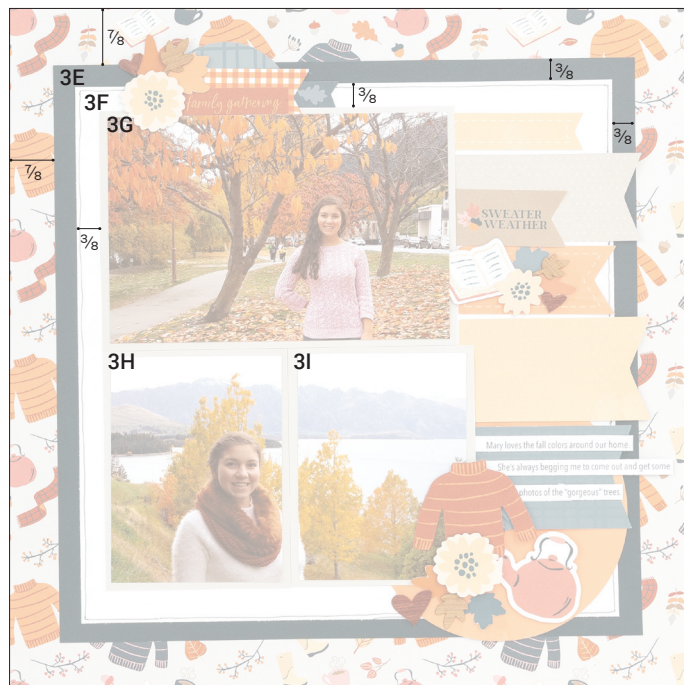
Project 3: Left Page



Assemble:

1. Use White Daisy cardstock for base page
2. Attach 3A and 3B
3. Attach 3C
Tip: Do not use adhesive along the bottom right corner so other pieces can be tucked behind it in a later step.
4. Attach photo to 3C
5. Attach 3D with thin 3-D foam tape
6. Attach photo to 3D
7. (Optional) Color wood stickers with middle and darkest Gold Yellow blends and darkest Coral blend markers
Tips: For the hearts, layer the darkest Gold Yellow and darkest Coral blend markers to create the color shown. Keep the stickers on their backing sheet while coloring them.
8. Draw stitch lines on the large mink half circle die-cut with journaling pen, as shown
9. Embellish with stickers, wood stickers, and die-cuts, as shown
Tips: Attach a few of these pieces with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension. Tuck the large circle and leaves slightly behind 3C, as shown.

Project 3: Right Page



Assemble:

1. Use sweater paper for base page
2. Attach 3E
3. Draw border on 3F with journaling pen, as shown
4. Attach 3F
5. Attach 3G, 3H, and 3I
Tip: Do not use adhesive along the right edges of 3G and 3I so other pieces can be tucked behind them in a later step.
6. Attach photos
Tip: Do not use adhesive along the top of the top photo so other pieces can be tucked behind it in a later step.
7. (Optional) Color wood stickers with darkest Gold Yellow and Coral blend markers
Tips: For the hearts, layer the two markers to create the color shown. Keep the stickers on their backing sheet while coloring them.
8. Embellish with additional stickers, wood stickers, and die-cuts, as shown
Tips: Attach a few of these pieces with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension. Tuck the banner slightly behind the top photo and the large circle and banners under 3G and 3I, as shown.
