

### **Getting Started:**

- · Gather all materials needed.
- Trim all zip strips and set aside. The zip strip is the 1/2" accent paper along the top of each sheet of patterned paper.
- Check the cut orientation below each cutting guide image. This will show you how to cut the paper, keeping the patterns on your project pieces facing the right direction.
- Light grey pieces on your cutting guide are project pieces. White pieces are leftover paper.
- · As you cut the paper, label and sort the pieces as indicated in the cutting guide, creating a stack for each project.
- If there is a fold line present in a cutting diagram, cut the paper first before folding it. In order to die-cut two shapes at once, place the die on top of the folded paper or stack two paper pieces before running the paper through your die-cutting machine. Paper pieces that can be stacked for die-cutting will be labeled, "stack."

#### Assemble:

- 1. Prepare pieces shown above
- 2. Attach 3A, 3B, 3C, 3D, and 3E
- 3. Heat emboss border under 3A and above 3E, as shown Tips: Use the masking technique for the right edge of the border. If you can't see the ink as you attempt to line it up to create the longer line, stamp and emboss one section at a time. Be careful to only heat the newly stamped section each time to avoid over melting, and possibly burning, the previously embossed areas. Technique: With a sticky note, or scratch piece of paper, cover the edge of the card base, lined up with 3A and 3E. Ink the stamp and stamp on the card base, including the masked area. Remove the mask once you are done.
- 4. Stamp "DECK THE HALLS" on card base with Black ink, as shown
- 5. Attach bow and tree accents with thin 3-D foam tape, as shown
- 6. Embellish with gems

# Ink: VersaMark™ (with Princess Gold embossing powder) Tip: Heat Emboss and dovetail. Technique: Rub the surface of 4D with the anti-static pouch. Emboss the image by stamping with VersaMark™ ink, sprinkling the wet image with embossing powder, shaking off any excess powder, and heating with the heat tool until the powder and ink melt together.
