Getting Started:

- Gather all materials needed.
- Trim all zip strips and set aside. The zip strip is the ½" accent paper along the top of each sheet of patterned paper.
- Check the cut orientation below each cutting guide image. This will show you how to cut the paper, keeping the patterns on your project pieces facing the right direction.
- Light grey pieces on your cutting guide are project pieces. White pieces are leftover paper.
- As you cut the paper, label and sort the pieces as indicated in the cutting guide, creating a stack for each project.

## Project 1: Left Page



## (Optional) Prepare for Both Pages:

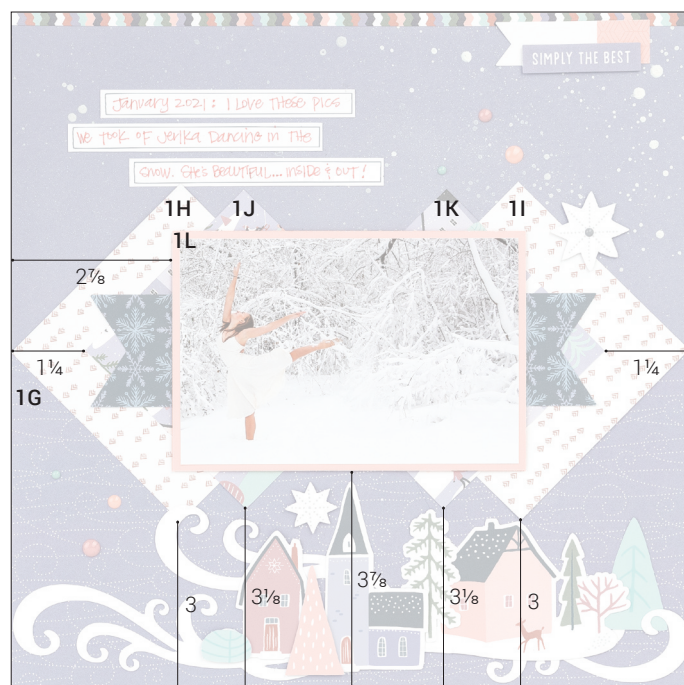
- Spray the top halves of both Wisteria cardstock base pages with white gloss spray, as desired, then set aside to dry  
*Tips: Spray the pages from approx. 8 inches away and in an area you don't mind getting messy. Gloss sprays stain.*



## Assemble:

1. Use prepared Wisteria cardstock for base page
2. Attach 1A
3. Attach 1B
4. Attach 1C, 1D, 1E, and 1F
5. Attach photos
6. Embellish with die-cuts and stickers, as shown  
*Tips: Attach a few of these pieces with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension. The border sticker along the top is cut in half, lengthwise, and the other half is used on the right page.*
7. Embellish with dots

## Project 1: Right Page



### Assemble:

1. Use prepared Wisteria cardstock for base page
2. Attach 1G
3. Attach 1H and 1I  
*Tip: The inside points will touch.*
4. Attach 1J and 1K  
*Tip: The inside points will overlap.*
5. Attach large dovetailed die-cut, as shown
6. Attach 1L
7. Attach photo
8. Embellish with stickers and additional die-cuts, as shown  
*Tips: Attach a few of these pieces with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension. The border sticker along the top is the other half of the border sticker used on the left page.*
9. Add journaling to journaling die-cuts, and attach, as shown
10. Embellish with dots



## Project 2: Left Page



### Assemble:

1. Use hat paper for base page
2. Attach 2A
3. Attach two 4" x 4" and one 5" x 7" photo to back of lined overlay die-cut
4. Attach prepared lined overlay die-cut
5. Embellish with stickers and additional die-cuts  
*Tip: Attach a few of these pieces with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.*
6. Embellish with dots

## Project 2: Right Page



### Assemble:

1. Use hat paper for base page
2. Attach 2B
3. Attach 2D and 2E to 2C
 

*Tips: Hand trim any excess hanging off the edges. Do not use adhesive along the left half of 2D so other pieces can be tucked behind it in a later step.*
4. Attach prepared 2C
5. Attach Wisteria dot streamer die-cuts
6. Attach 2F
 

*Tip: Do not use adhesive along the bottom left corner so another piece can be tucked behind it in a later step.*
7. Attach photo
8. Embellish with stickers and die-cuts, as shown
 

*Tips: Attach a few of these pieces with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension. Tuck mountain die-cut slightly behind 2D and 2F.*
9. Embellish with dots
10. Add journaling



### Project 3: Left Page



### (Optional) Prepare for Both Pages:

- Spray 3A, 3B, 3C, 3D, and the "GOOD TIMES" die-cut mat with white gloss spray  
*Tips: Spray these pieces from approx. 8 inches away and in an area you don't mind getting messy. Gloss sprays stain.*



### Assemble:

- Use Glacier dot paper for base page
- Attach prepared 3A, 3B, and 3C
- Attach photos
- Embellish with snowflake and flourish stickers, and White Daisy and Wisteria snowflake die-cuts, as shown  
*Tips: Lay these pieces out on the page first, before attaching. When you're ready, attach a few of these pieces with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension. Attach the Wisteria snowflakes with the glue pen.*
- Attach "SNOW fun" sticker with thin 3-D foam tape
- Embellish with dots



### Project 3: Right Page



#### Assemble:

1. Use Glacier dot paper for base page
2. Attach photo to 3D
3. Attach prepared 3D  
*Tip: Do not use adhesive along the top so another piece can be tucked behind it in a later step.*
4. Attach journaling die-cut, as shown  
*Tip: Tuck slightly behind 3D.*
5. Attach prepared "GOOD TIMES" die-cut mat
6. Attach sprigs patterned Wisteria die-cut mat to "GOOD TIMES" die-cut mat, as shown
7. Attach 4" x 6" photo
8. Embellish with snowflake and flourish stickers, and White Daisy and Wisteria snowflake die-cuts, as shown  
*Tips: Lay these pieces out on the page first, before attaching. When you're ready, attach a few of these pieces with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension. Attach the Wisteria snowflakes with the glue pen.*
9. Embellish with additional stickers  
*Tip: Attach a few of these with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.*
10. Embellish with dots
11. Add journaling
