# **Getting Started:**

- Gather all materials needed.
- Trim all zip strips and set aside. The zip strip is the ½" accent paper along the top of each sheet of patterned paper.
- Check the cut orientation below each cutting guide image. This will show you how to cut the paper, keeping the patterns on your project pieces facing the right direction.
- Light grey pieces on your cutting guide are project pieces. White pieces are leftover paper.
- · As you cut the paper, label and sort the pieces as indicated in the cutting guide, creating a stack for each project.

★ = first cut | \* = use back of paper cut diagonal = angle in trimmer












Tip: Lightly draw a diagonal line with a pencil and ruler, from one corner of the paper to the other. Use this guideline to cut the paper in half using scissors (it will not fit in a standard size paper trimmer).










#### Assemble:

- 1. Use White Daisy cardstock for base page
- 2. Attach 1A
- 3. Attach 1B

- 4. Attach photos to 1C and 1D
- 5. Attach 1C and 1D

Tip: Do not use adhesive along the top left corner of 1C so other pieces can be tucked behind it in a later step.

- 6. Embellish with die-cuts and stickers, as shown Tips: Attach a few of these pieces with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension. Tuck some pieces slightly behind 1C, as shown
- 7. (Optional) Stamp triangle border on base page with Harbour ink, as shown

Tip: Use the masking technique.

Technique: Place a scratch piece of paper, or sticky note, as a mask to cover the area of your project that you don't want stamped. Stamp your image on the project and then remove the mask.





#### Assemble:

- 1. Use White Daisy cardstock for base page
- 2. Attach 1E and Wisteria triangle die-cut
- 3. Attach 1F, 1G, and 1H

Tip: Attach 1H with thin 3-D foam tape.

- 4. Attach 1I and 1J with thin 3-D foam tape Tip: Do not use adhesive along the left side of 1I so other pieces can be tucked behind it in a later step.
- 5. Attach 1K with thin 3-D foam tape
- 6. Attach photos
- 7. Attach 1L and 1M
- 8. (Optional) Stamp stitched border on base page with Harbour ink, as shown, for journaling
- 9. Embellish with die-cuts and stickers, as shown Tips: Attach a few of these pieces with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension. Tuck some pieces slightly behind 11, as shown.
- 10. Add journaling





#### Assemble:

- 1. Use White Daisy cardstock for base page
- 2. Lightly draw vertical guidelines on base page with a pencil and ruler, 1" and 2%" from left edge
- 3. Attach semicircle die-cuts along guidelines, as shown *Tip: Trim any excess hanging off the top or bottom of the page with scissors.*
- 4. Attach 2A
- 5. Attach 2B
- 6. Attach photos to 2C and 2D
- 7. Attach 2C and 2D with thin 3-D foam tape

  Tip: Do not use adhesive along the left edge of 2C so other pieces can be tucked behind it in a later step.
- 8. Attach 2E
- 9. Embellish with die-cuts and stickers, as shown Tips: Attach a few of these pieces with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension. Tuck a few pieces behind 2C.
- 10. Add journaling

# **Project 2: Right Page**





#### Assemble:

- 1. Use White Daisy cardstock for base page
- 2. Attach 2F
- 3. Lightly draw a vertical guideline on base page with a pencil and ruler,  $2\frac{1}{4}$ " from right edge
- 4. Attach semicircle die-cuts along edge of 2F and guideline, as shown
  - Tip: Trim the end pieces, as shown.
- 5. Attach 2G
- 6. Attach 2H
- 7. Attach photos
- 8. Embellish with die-cuts and stickers, as shown Tip: Attach a few of these pieces with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.
- 9. Add journaling

# **Prepare for Left Page:**

- (Optional) Stamp borders on Mint and smaller Wisteria die-cut strips with Harbour ink, as shown
- Angle cut Mint and Wisteria die-cuts, as shown
- Attach Sundance scalloped border sticker to larger Wisteria diecut strip, as shown

Tip: Trim the excess and save it for the right page.

#### Assemble:

- 1. Use exclusive Ballerina dot paper for base page
- 2. Attach large title die-cut to 3A
- 3. Attach prepared title die-cut

  Tip: Do not use adhesive along the right edge so other pieces can be tucked behind it in a later step.
- 4. Dovetail or angle cut 3B, 3C, 3D, 3F, 3I, 3J, and 3K, as shown
- 5. Attach 3B–3K and prepared Wisteria and Mint die-cut strips, as shown

Tips: Before attaching them, lay the paper strips out to figure out the spacing. When you're ready to attach, tuck these slightly behind the title.

- 6. Attach 3L with thin 3-D foam tape
- 7. Attach photo
- 8. Embellish with die-cuts and stickers, as shown *Tip: Attach a few of these pieces with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.*

## **Project 3: Right Page**





#### Assemble:

- 1. Use exclusive Ballerina dot paper for base page
- 2. Attach photos
- 3. (Optional) Stamp stitched border on 3N with Harbour ink, as shown, for journaling
  - Tip: Use the masking technique along the left and right edges.
  - Technique: Place a scratch piece of paper, or sticky note, as a mask to cover the edges of 3N that you don't want stamped. Stamp the stitched lines on 3N and the masks, and then remove the masks.
- 4. (Optional) Stamp diamond border along left edge of bottom left photo, as shown
  - Tip: Use the masking technique.
- 5. Attach 3N to 3M, as shown6. Dovetail and attach 3M
- 7. Embellish with die-cuts and stickers, as shown

  Tip: Attach a few of these pieces with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.
- 8. Dovetail and attach 3O
- 9. Add journaling
