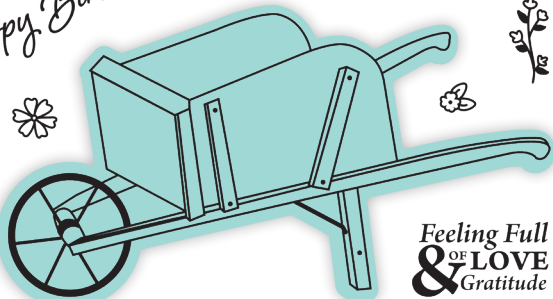
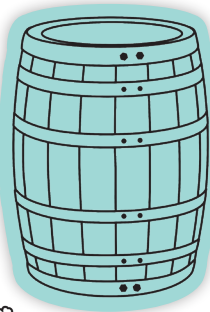

Getting Started:

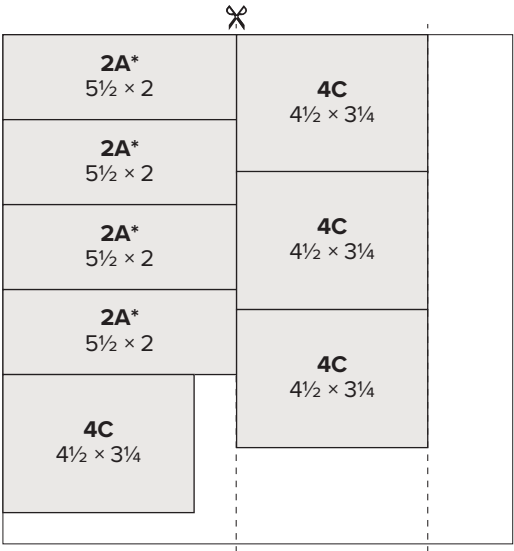
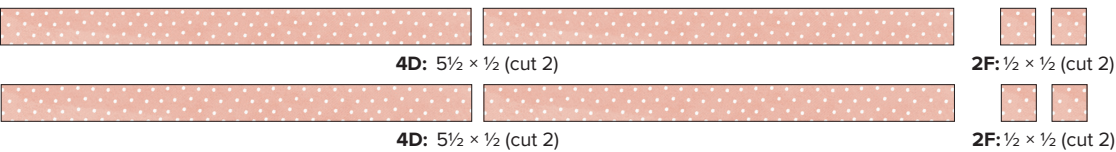
- Gather all materials needed.
- Trim all zip strips and set aside. The zip strip is the 1/2" accent paper along the top of each sheet of patterned paper.
- Check the cut orientation below each cutting guide image. This will show you how to cut the paper, keeping the patterns on your project pieces facing the right direction.
- Light grey pieces on your cutting guide are project pieces. White pieces are leftover paper.
- As you cut the paper, label and sort the pieces as indicated in the cutting guide, creating a stack for each project.
- If there is a fold line present in a cutting diagram, cut the paper first before folding it. In order to die-cut two shapes at once, place the die on top of the folded paper or stack two paper pieces before running the paper through your die-cutting machine. Paper pieces that can be stacked for die-cutting will be labeled, "stack."

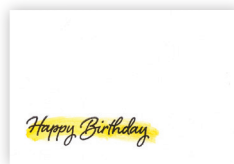
## Project 1: Make 4



## Prepare (4 each):

### 1C:

Paper: White Daisy  
Ink: Intense Black  
Tip: Add swash with watercolor paint and a waterbrush, first, then stamp "Happy Birthday" once the paint is dry. (yellow—4)



### 1F:

Paper: light Papaya  
Ink: Papaya  
Tip: Dovetail.



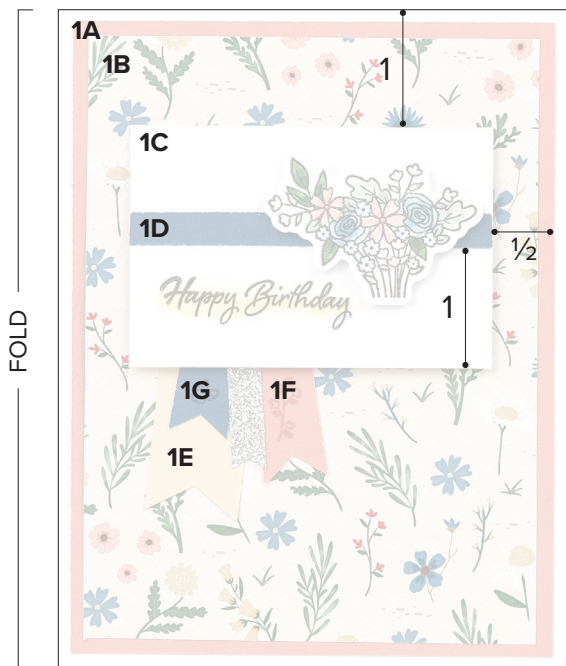
### 1G:

Paper: light Sapphire  
Ink: Sapphire  
Tip: Dovetail.



### P1 Accent:

Paper: White Daisy  
Ink: Intense Black  
Tip: Once the ink is dry, add color with watercolor paints and a waterbrush. (green—mix 28 and 30, pink—mix 10 and 11, blue—25).



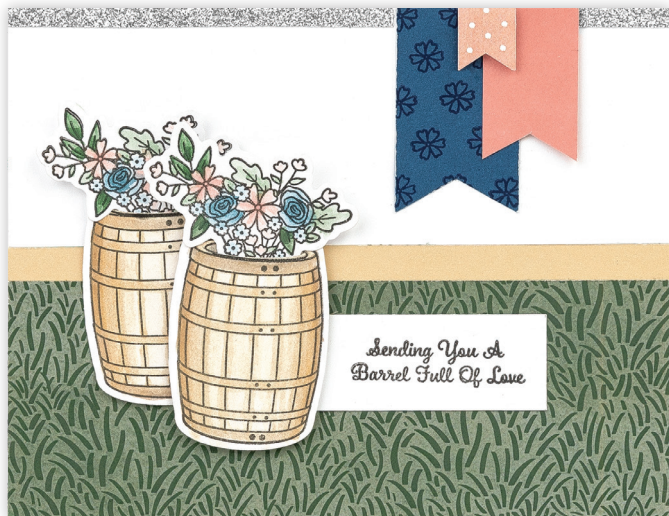
## Assemble:

1. Prepare pieces shown above
2. Attach 1A
3. Attach 1B
4. Attach prepared 1C with 3-D foam tape  
*Tip: Do not use adhesive along the bottom so other pieces can be tucked behind it in a later step.*
5. Attach 1D
6. Dovetail and attach 1E and prepared 1F, as shown  
*Tip: Tuck slightly behind 1C.*
7. Embellish with shimmer trim  
*Tip: Cut a 1" piece of trim, dovetail one end, and attach as shown.*
8. Attach prepared 1G  
*Tip: Tuck slightly behind 1C.*
9. Attach prepared flower accent with 3-D foam tape, as shown



## Project 2: Make 4

## Prepare (4 each):



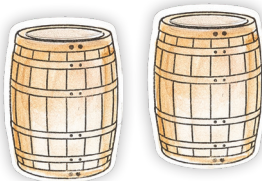
### 2C:

Paper: White Daisy  
Ink: Intense Black



### 2D:

Paper: light Sapphire  
Ink: Sapphire  
Tip: Dovetail.



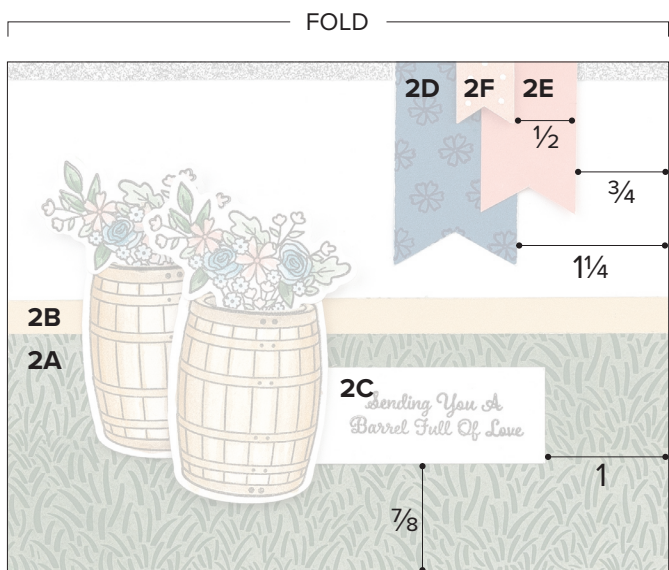
### P2 Accents:

Paper: White Daisy  
Ink: Intense Black  
Tips: Once the ink is dry, add color with watercolor paints and a waterbrush. Make 2 per card. (tan—mix 8 and 33)



### P2 Accents:

Paper: White Daisy  
Ink: Intense Black  
Tip: Once the ink is dry, add color with watercolor paints and a waterbrush. Make 2 per card. (green—mix 28 and 30, pink—mix 10 and 11, blue—25)



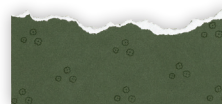
## Assemble:

1. Prepare pieces shown above
2. Attach 2A and 2B
3. Embellish card base with shimmer trim  
*Tip: Hand trim excess from the top and the edges of the card base after attaching.*
4. Attach 2C
5. Attach prepared 2D
6. Dovetail and attach 2E and 2F  
*Tip: Attach 2F with 3-D foam tape.*
7. Attach prepared barrel accents, as shown  
*Tip: Attach the one in the front with 3-D foam tape.*
8. Attach prepared flower accents, as shown  
*Tips: These accents will slide into the slits on the top of the barrels. Attach the one in the front barrel with 3-D foam tape.*

## Project 3: Make 4



## Prepare (4 each):



### 3A:

Paper: Pine  
Ink: Pine  
Tip: Tear approx. 1/4" from one long side.



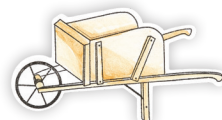
### 3B:

Paper: light Pine  
Tip: Tear approx. 1/4" from one long side.



### 3E:

Paper: White Daisy  
Ink: Intense Black



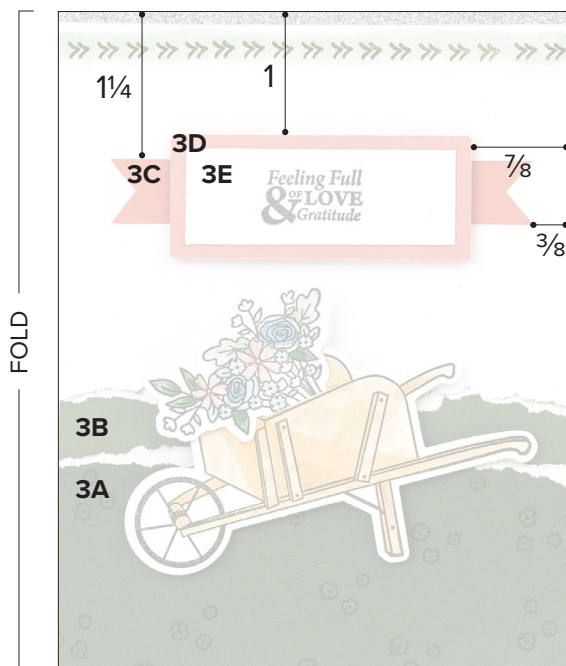
### P3 Accent:

Paper: White Daisy  
Ink: Intense Black  
Tip: Once the ink is dry, add color with watercolor paints and a waterbrush. (tan—mix 8 and 33)



### P3 Accent:

Paper: White Daisy  
Ink: Intense Black  
Tip: Once the ink is dry, add color with watercolor paints and a waterbrush. (green—mix 28 and 30, pink—mix 10 and 11, blue—25)



## Assemble:

1. Prepare pieces shown above
2. Embellish card base with shimmer trim  
*Tip: Hand trim excess from the top and the edges of the card base after attaching.*
3. Paint a light swash below shimmer trim, as shown (green—mix 28 and 30)
4. Once paint is dry, stamp border on top of paint swash with Pine ink, as shown
5. Attach prepared 3A  
*Tip: Do not use adhesive along the top so another piece can be tucked behind it in a later step.*
6. Attach prepared 3B  
*Tip: Tuck slightly behind 3A.*
7. Dovetail and attach 3C
8. Attach 3D with 3-D foam tape
9. Attach prepared 3E
10. Attach prepared wheelbarrow accent with 3-D foam tape, as shown
11. Attach prepared flower accent with 3-D foam tape, as shown  
*Tip: This accent will slide into a slit on the wheelbarrow.*

## Project 4: Make 4

## Prepare (4):

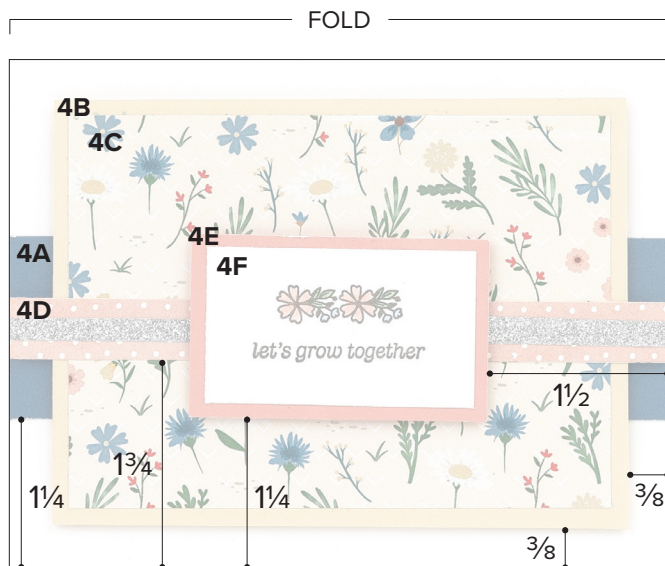


### 4F:

Paper: White Daisy

Ink: Intense Black

Tip: Once the ink is dry, add color with watercolor paints and a waterbrush. (green—mix 28 and 30, pink—mix 10 and 11, blue—25)



## Assemble:

1. Prepare piece shown above
2. Attach 4A
3. Attach 4B with 3-D foam tape
4. Attach 4C
5. Attach 4D
  - Tip: Use 3-D foam tape on the ends.
6. Embellish 4D with shimmer trim
  - Tip: Trim shimmer trim to  $5\frac{1}{2}$ "  $\times$   $\frac{1}{8}$ ".
7. Attach 4E with 3-D foam tape
8. Attached prepared 4F
