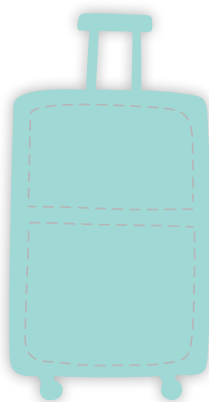

Getting Started:

- Gather all materials needed.
- Trim all zip strips and set aside. The zip strip is the ½" accent paper along the top of each sheet of patterned paper.
- Check the cut orientation below each cutting guide image. This will show you how to cut the paper, keeping the patterns on your project pieces facing the right direction.
- Light grey pieces on your cutting guide are project pieces. White pieces are leftover paper.
- As you cut the paper, label and sort the pieces as indicated in the cutting guide, creating a stack for each project.
- If there is a fold line present in a cutting diagram, cut the paper first before folding it. In order to die-cut two shapes at once, place the die on top of the folded paper or stack two paper pieces before running the paper through your die-cutting machine. Paper pieces that can be stacked for die-cutting will be labeled, "stack."

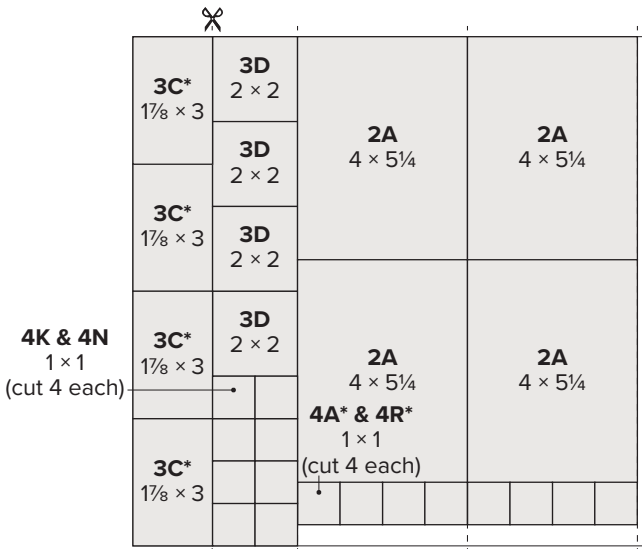

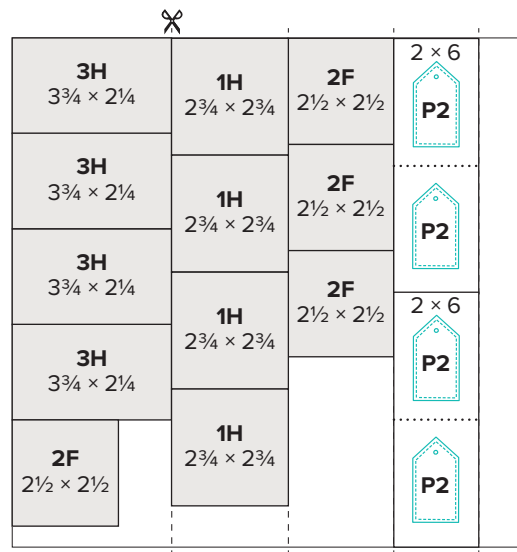
Papaya cardstock

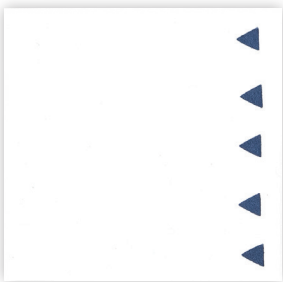
White Daisy cardstock

Project 1: Make 4

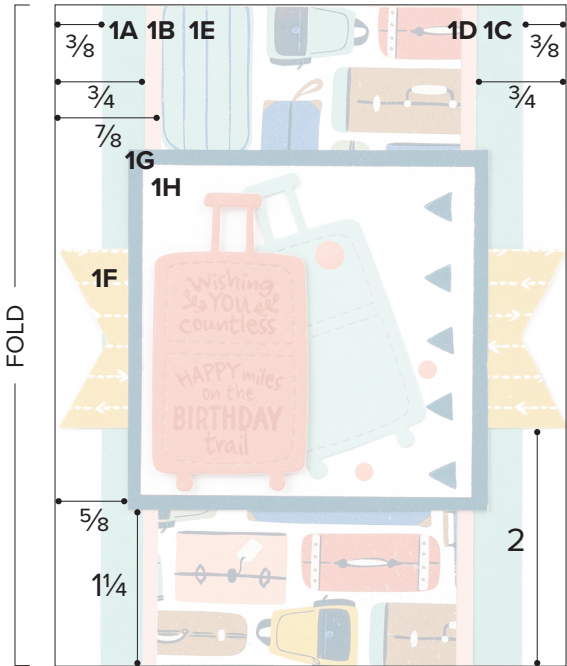
Prepare (4 each):



1H:
Paper: White Daisy
Ink: Sapphire



P1 Accent:
Paper: Papaya
Ink: Papaya



Assemble:

1. Prepare pieces shown above
2. Attach 1A and 1B
3. Attach 1C and 1D
4. Attach 1E
5. Dovetail and attach 1F
6. Attach 1G
7. Attach prepared 1H
8. Attach P1 suitcase accents, as shown
Tip: Attach prepared Papaya suitcase with 3-D foam tape.
9. Embellish with dots

Project 2: Make 4

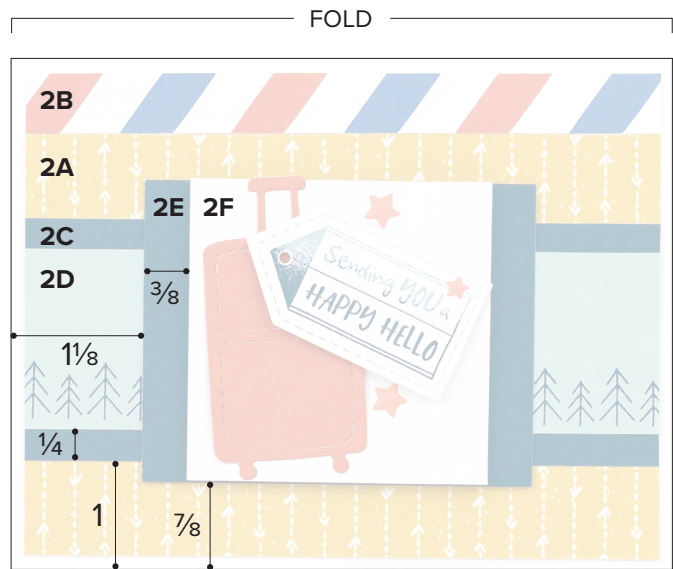
Prepare (4 each):



2D:
Paper: light Glacier
Ink: Sapphire



P2 Accent:
Paper: White Daisy
Inks: Glacier, Sapphire
Tip: Use the ombré stamping technique.
Technique: Ink the top of the stamp with Glacier and the bottom with Sapphire, overlapping colors in the middle.



Assemble:

1. Prepare pieces shown above
2. Attach 2A and 2B
3. Attach 2C and prepared 2D
4. Attach 2E
5. Attach 2F with 3-D foam tape
6. Attach P2 Papaya cardstock suitcase accent, as shown
7. Attach prepared tag accent with 3-D foam tape, as shown
8. Embellish with dots

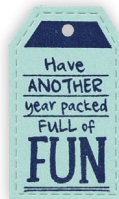

Ink: Papaya



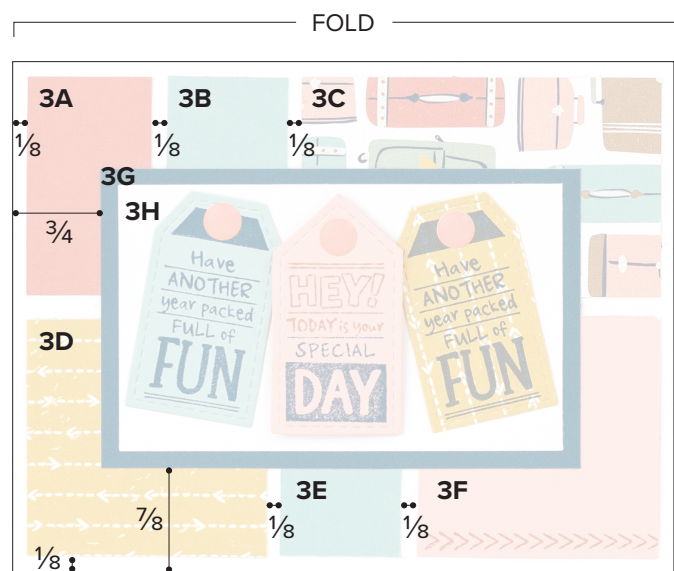
P3 Accent:
Paper: light Glacier
Ink: Sapphire



P3 Accent:
Paper: light Peach
Inks: Papaya, Sapphire
Tip: Use the selective inking technique.
Technique: Ink the top of the stamp with Papaya and the bottom with Sapphire.



P3 Accent:
Paper: Honey Butter arrow
Ink: Sapphire



Assemble:

1. Prepare pieces shown above
2. Attach 3A, 3B, and 3C
3. Attach 3D, 3E, and prepared 3F
4. Attach 3G
5. Attach 3H
6. Attach prepared tag accents, as shown
Tip: Attach the Peach tag with 3-D foam tape.
7. Embellish with dots

Project 4: Make 4



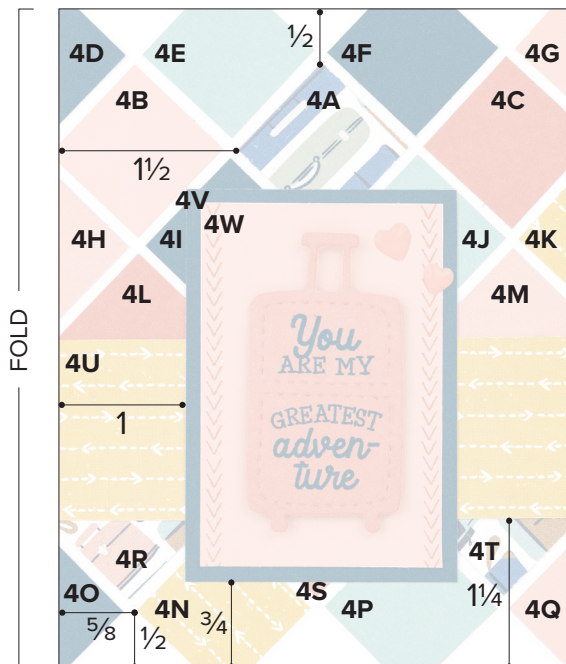
Prepare (4 each):



4W:
Paper: light Peach
Ink: Papaya



P4 Accent:
Paper: light Papaya
Ink: Sapphire



Assemble:

1. Prepare pieces shown above
2. Attach 4A
3. Attach 4B–4M, as shown
Tips: Each diamond is 1/8" apart. Trim any excess coming off the card's edges.
4. Attach 4N
5. Attach 4O–4T
Tips: Each diamond is 1/8" apart. Trim any excess coming off the card's edges.
6. Attach 4U
7. Attach 4V
8. Attach prepared 4W
9. Attach prepared suitcase accent with 3-D foam tape, as shown
10. Embellish with dots
