- Z4601 Balmy Night Shimmer Spray (optional)
- Z2060 Thin 3-D Foam Tape
- Z2089 Glue Dots® Micro Dots

- Paper Trimmer
- Scissors
- Adhesive
- Ruler

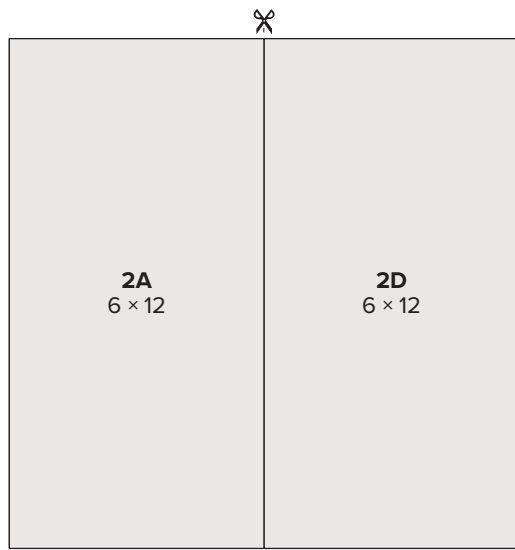
Getting Started:

- Gather all materials needed.
- Trim all zip strips and set aside. The zip strip is the ½" accent paper along the top of each sheet of patterned paper.
- Check the cut orientation below each cutting guide image. This will show you how to cut the paper, keeping the patterns on your project pieces facing the right direction.
- Light grey pieces on your cutting guide are project pieces. White pieces are leftover paper.
- As you cut the paper, label and sort the pieces as indicated in the cutting guide, creating a stack for each project.

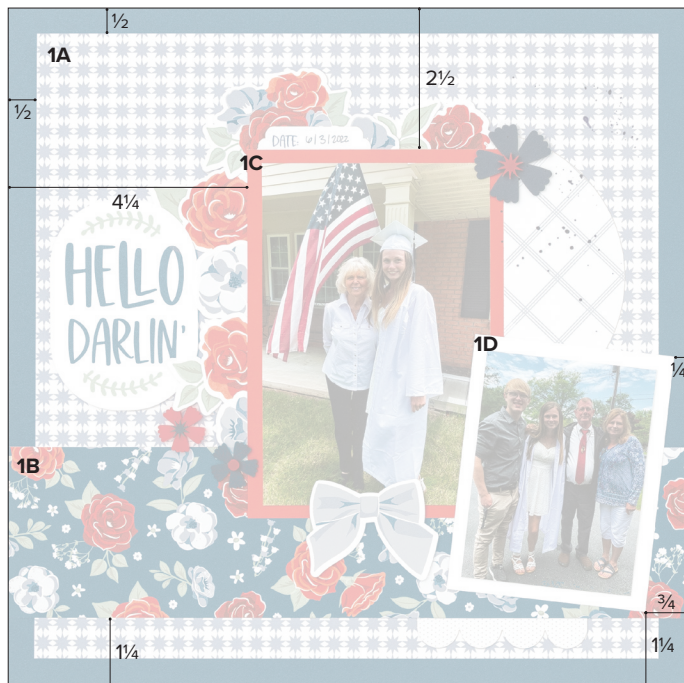


Project 1: Left Page



Prepare (for both pages):

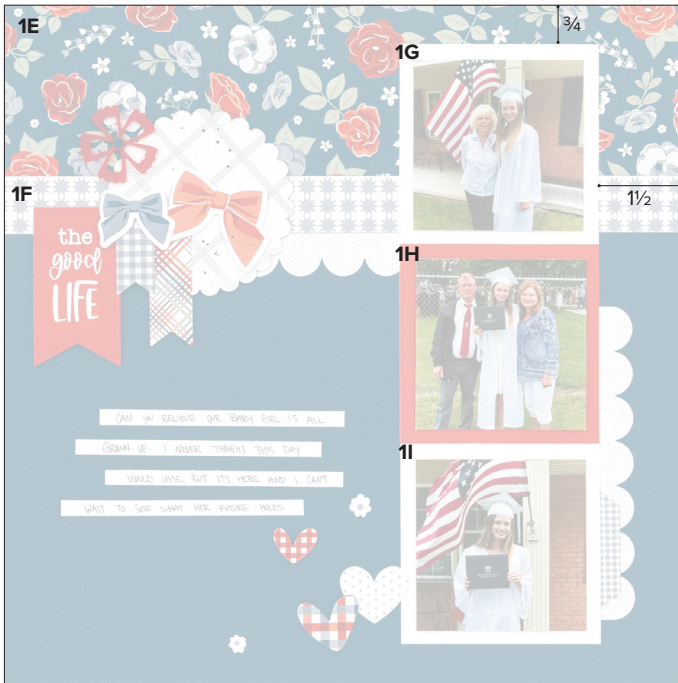
- (Optional) Spray 1A, large plaid circle die-cut, and plaid scalloped circle die-cut with balmy night shimmer spray
Tip: Spray the paper and die-cuts from approx. 8" away and in an area you don't mind getting messy. Shimmer sprays stain.



Assemble:

1. Use Sapphire cardstock for base page
2. Attach prepared 1A
3. Attach 1B
Tip: Do not use adhesive along the bottom right so another piece can be tucked behind it in a later step.
4. Attach 1C
Tip: Do not use adhesive along the top and left edge so other pieces can be tucked behind it in a later step.
5. Attach photo to 1C
6. Embellish with stickers and die-cuts, including prepared die-cut
Tips: Tuck a few of these embellishments slightly behind 1B and 1C, and attach a few others with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.
7. Embellish with acrylic shapes
Tip: Attach with glue dots.
8. Attach 1D with thin 3-D foam tape
9. Attach remaining photo

Project 1: Right Page



Assemble:

1. Use Sapphire cardstock for base page
2. Attach 1E and 1F
Tip: Do not use adhesive along the bottom of 1F so another piece can be tucked behind it in a later step.
3. Attach one scalloped border die-cut
Tip: Tuck slightly behind 1F.
4. Attach 1G, 1H, and 1I
Tip: Do not use adhesive along the right edge of 1H and 1I so other pieces can be tucked behind them in a later step.
5. Attach remaining die-cuts, including prepared die-cut
Tips: Tuck a couple of die-cuts slightly behind 1H and 1I, and attach a few others with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.
6. Embellish with stickers
Tip: Attach a few stickers with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.
7. Embellish with acrylic shape
Tip: Attach with glue dots.
8. Attach photos with thin 3-D foam tape
9. Add journaling

Project 2: Left Page



Prepare (for both pages):

- (Optional) Spray 2B and 2E with balmy night shimmer spray
Tip: Spray the cardstock from approx. 8 inches away and in an area you don't mind getting messing. Shimmer sprays stain.



Assemble:

1. Use Candy Apple star patterned paper for base page
2. Attach 2A
3. Attach prepared 2B
4. Attach 2C
Tip: Only use adhesive in the center so other pieces can be tucked behind the edges in a later step.
5. Attach photo with thin 3-D foam tape
6. Attach die-cuts, as shown
Tip: Attach a few die-cuts with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.
7. Embellish with circle sticker and acrylic shapes
Tips: Attach sticker with 3-D foam tape for added dimension. Attach the acrylic shapes with glue dots.
8. Add journaling

Project 2: Right Page



Assemble:

1. Use Candy Apple star patterned paper for base page
2. Attach 2D
3. Attach prepared 2E
4. Attach 2F and 2G
Tip: Do not use adhesive along the right bottom corner of 2G so other pieces can be tucked behind it in a later step.
5. Attach 2H and 2I
Tip: Do not use adhesive along the top of 2H and the left edge of 2I so other pieces can be tucked behind them in a later step.
6. Attach die-cuts, as shown
Tip: Attach a few die-cuts with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.
7. Embellish with stickers and acrylic shapes
Tips: Attach a few stickers with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension. Attach acrylic shapes with glue dots. Tuck the pinwheel sticker slightly behind 2I.

Project 3: Left Page



Prepare (for both pages):

- (Optional) Spray both star overlay die-cuts with balmy night shimmer spray
Tip: Spray the die-cuts from approx. 8 inches away and in an area you don't mind getting messy. Shimmer sprays stain.



Assemble:

1. Use exclusive Mist floral patterned paper for base page
2. Attach photos to back side of prepared star overlay die-cut
3. Attach prepared star overlay die-cut to base page
4. Attach remaining die-cuts, as shown
Tip: Attach a few of these with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.
5. Embellish with stickers and acrylic shapes
Tips: Attach a few stickers with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension. Attach the acrylic shapes with glue dots.

Project 3: Right Page



Assemble:

1. Use exclusive Mist floral patterned paper for base page
2. Attach photos to back side of prepared star overlay die-cut
3. Attach prepared star overlay die-cut to base page
4. Attach remaining die-cuts, as shown
Tip: Attach a few die-cuts with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.
5. Embellish with acrylic shapes
Tip: Attach with glue dots.
6. Add journaling
