- G1289 Home for Christmas Scrapbooking Workshop Kit
- Z5010 White Gloss Spray (optional)
- Z1513 White Gel Pens (optional)
- Z4575 Black LePen™

- Z1151 3-D Foam Tape
- Paper Trimmer
- Scissors
- Adhesive
- Ruler

Getting Started:

- Gather all materials needed.
- Trim all zip strips and set aside. The zip strip is the ½" accent paper along the top of each sheet of patterned paper.
- Check the cut orientation below each cutting guide image. This will show you how to cut the paper, keeping the patterns on your project pieces facing the right direction.
- Light grey pieces on your cutting guide are project pieces. White pieces are leftover paper.
- As you cut the paper, label and sort the pieces as indicated in the cutting guide, creating a stack for each project.

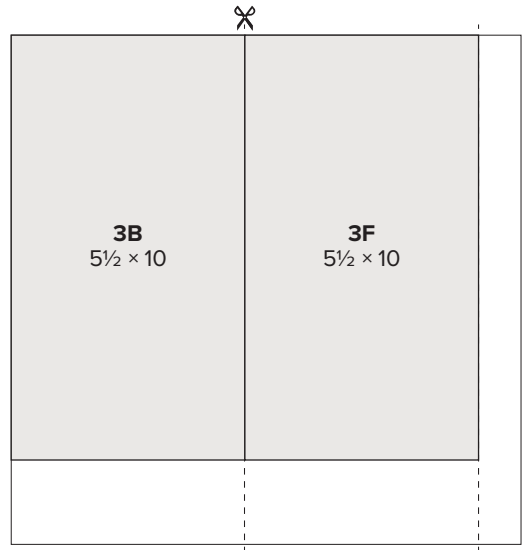


Candy Apple cardstock

Project 1: Left Page



Prepare (for both pages):

- (Optional) Spray both base pages (12" x 12" Pine patterned paper) with white gloss spray, then set aside to dry
Tip: Spray the paper from approx. 8 inches away and in an area you don't mind getting messy. Gloss sprays stain.
- (Optional) Add details to Black, Pine, and Candy Apple die-cuts with White Gel Pen (.08), as shown



Assemble:

1. Use prepared Pine patterned paper for base page
2. Attach large plaid scalloped die-cuts
3. Attach 1A and 1B
4. Attach Mink scalloped die-cut, as shown
5. Attach 1C
6. Attach photo
7. Attach journaling die-cut, as shown
8. Embellish with sticker and additional die-cuts, including prepared die-cuts
Tip: Attach a few of these embellishments with 3-D foam tape for added dimension.
9. Add journaling

Project 1: Right Page



Assemble:

1. Use prepared Pine patterned paper for base page
2. Attach large plaid scalloped die-cuts
3. Attach 1D and 1E
4. Attach 1F, 1G, and 1H
5. Attach photos
Tip: Attach the 4" x 6" photo with 3-D foam tape.
6. Embellish with sticker and additional die-cuts, including prepared die-cuts
Tip: Attach a few of these embellishments with 3-D foam tape for added dimension.

Project 2: Left Page

Prepare (for both pages):



- (Optional) Spray 2A with white gloss spray, as desired, then set aside to dry
Tip: Spray the cardstock from approx. 8 inches away and in an area you don't mind getting messy. Gloss sprays stain.
- (Optional) Add details to Black, Pine, and Candy Apple die-cuts with White Gel Pen (.08), as shown



Assemble:

1. Use exclusive gingham patterned paper for base page
2. Attach prepared 2A
3. Attach 2B, 2C, and 2D
4. Attach photos with 3-D foam tape
5. Embellish with stickers and die-cuts, including prepared die-cuts
Tip: Attach a few of these embellishments with 3-D foam tape for added dimension.
6. Add journaling

Project 2: Right Page



Assemble:

1. Use exclusive gingham patterned paper for base page
2. Attach 2E and 2F
3. Attach left photos
4. Attach 2G and 2H
5. Attach right photos

6. Embellish with stickers and die-cuts, including prepared die-cuts

Tips: Attach a few of these embellishments with 3-D foam tape for added dimension.

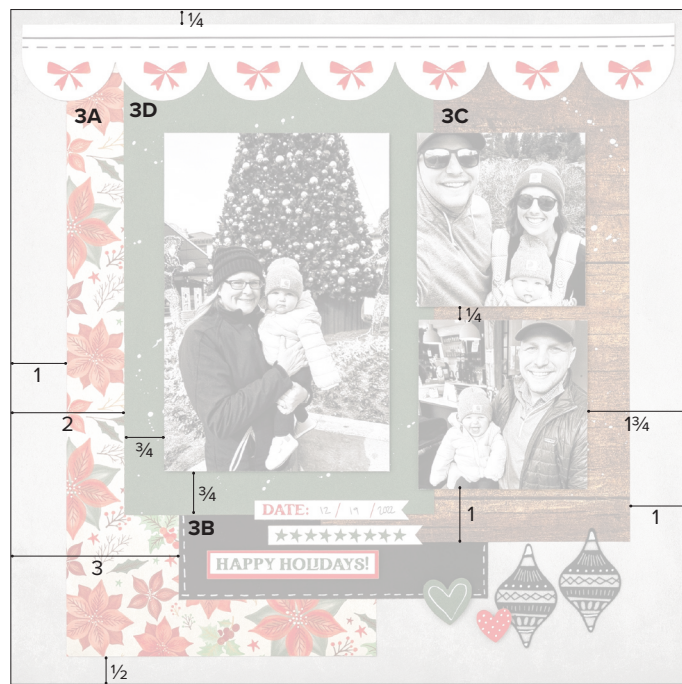
7. Add journaling

Project 3: Left Page



Prepare (for both pages):

- (Optional) Splatter 3C, 3D, 3G, and 3H with white gloss spray, then set aside to dry
Tip: Work in an area you don't mind getting messy. Gloss sprays stain.
Technique: Shake the bottle well, with the cap on. Unscrew the spray cap and then, holding the pump straw horizontally, very gently tap the spray cap above the area where you want the droplets to land. Protect any surrounding areas, where you don't want the splatters, with scratch paper.
- (Optional) Add details to 3B, 3F, and Black, Pine, and Candy Apple die-cuts, with White Gel Pen (.08), as shown



Assemble:

1. Use exclusive Mink patterned paper for base page
2. Attach 3A
3. Attach prepared 3B, 3C, and 3D
Tip: The top of each of these papers lines up with the top of 3A.
4. Attach photos with 3-D foam tape
5. Embellish with die-cuts, including prepared die-cuts
Tip: Attach a few of these embellishments with 3-D foam tape for added dimension.
6. Add journaling

Project 3: Right Page



Assemble:

1. Use exclusive Mink patterned paper for base page
2. Attach 3E
3. Attach prepared 3F, 3G, and 3H
Tip: The top of each of these papers lines up with the top of 3E.
4. Attach photos with 3-D foam tape
5. Embellish with die-cuts, including prepared die-cuts
Tip: Attach a few of these embellishments with 3-D foam tape for added dimension.
6. Add journaling
