Getting Started:

- Gather all materials needed.
- Trim all zip strips and set aside. The zip strip is the 1/2" accent paper along the top of each sheet of patterned paper.
- Check the cut orientation below each cutting guide image. This will show you how to cut the paper, keeping the patterns on your project pieces facing the right direction.
- Light grey pieces on your cutting guide are project pieces. White pieces, not including labeled project pieces that must be die cut, are leftover paper.
- As you cut the paper, label and sort the pieces as indicated in the cutting guide, creating a stack for each project.
- If there is a fold line present in a cutting diagram, cut the paper first before folding it. In order to die-cut two shapes at once, place the die on top of the folded paper or stack two paper pieces before running the paper through your die-cutting machine. Paper pieces that can be stacked for die-cutting will be labeled, "stack."

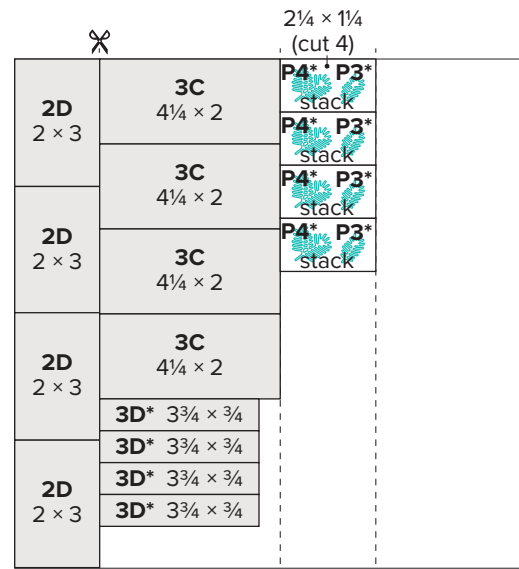

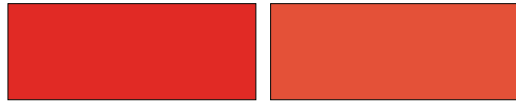

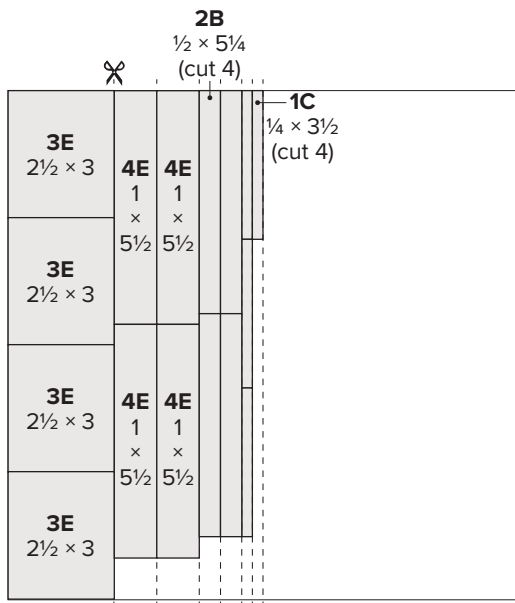


Candy Apple cardstock

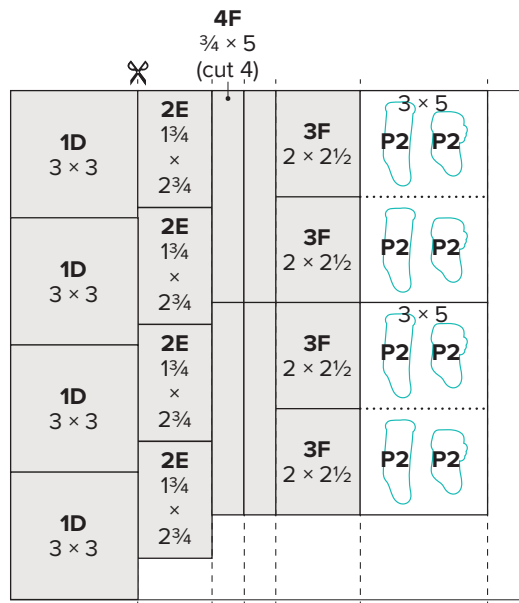

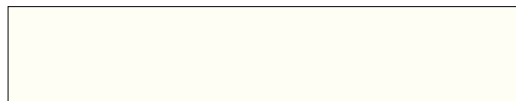

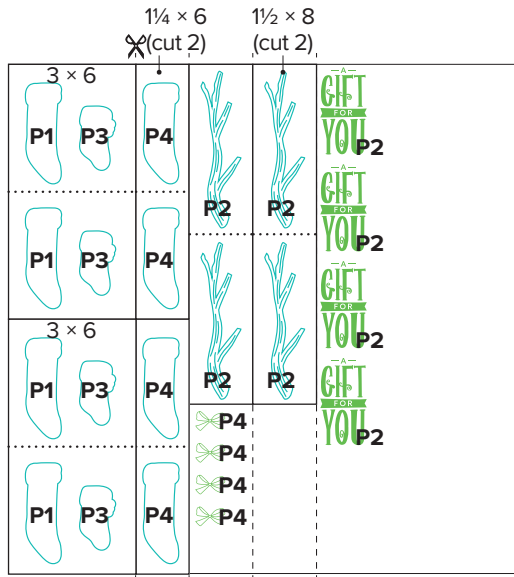
Black cardstock

Project 1: Make 4

Prepare (4 each):

Tip: Consider making all of the Prepare pieces for all of the projects now. Many of them have glitter glue on them, and this will give them more time to dry.



1B:
Paper: Pine
Ink: Intense Black



1C:
Paper: Black
Tip: Embellish with glitter glue and allow to dry.



1D:
Paper: French Vanilla
Inks: Intense Black, Pine
Tips: Color with colored pencils (Fiery Red, Pine Green). Embellish with glitter glue and allow to dry.



P1 Accent:
Paper: French Vanilla
Ink: Candy Apple
Tips: Color with colored pencil (Fiery Red). Embellish with glitter glue and allow to dry.



Assemble:

1. Prepare pieces shown above
2. Attach 1A and prepared 1B
3. Attach prepared 1C
4. Attach prepared 1D with 3-D foam tape
5. Attach prepared stocking accent with 3-D foam tape, as shown
6. Attach P1 light Pine cardstock branch accent, as shown
7. Embellish with sparkles

Project 2: Make 4

Prepare (4 each):



2C:
 Paper: Candy Apple
 Tips: Embellish with glitter glue and allow to dry. Use a ruler as a guide.



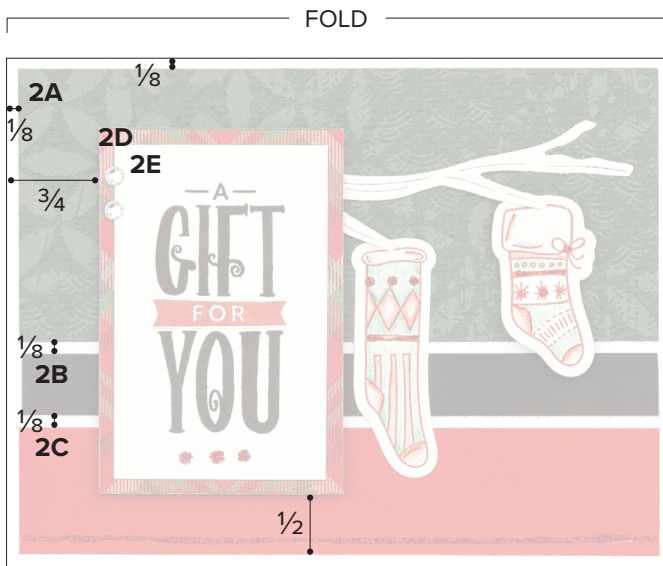
2E:
 Paper: French Vanilla
 Ink: Intense Black
 Tip: Embellish with glitter glue and allow to dry.



P2 Accents:
 Paper: French Vanilla
 Ink: Candy Apple
 Tips: Color with colored pencils (Fiery Red, Pine Green). Embellish with glitter glue and allow to dry.



P2 Accents:
 Paper: French Vanilla
 Ink: Candy Apple
 Tips: Hand trim "FOR" banner and attach to 2E.

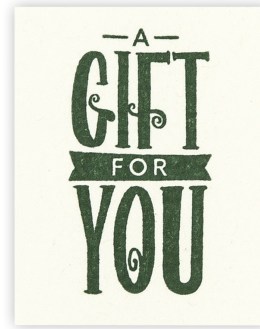


Assemble:

1. Prepare pieces shown above
2. Attach 2A, 2B, and prepared 2C
3. Attach 2D with 3-D foam tape
Tip: Do not use adhesive along the top right edge so other pieces can be tucked behind it in a later step.
4. Attach prepared 2E
5. Attach P2 French Vanilla branch accent, as shown
Tips: Tuck it slightly behind 2D. Do not use adhesive on the two lower branches so other pieces can be tucked behind them in a later step.
6. Attach prepared stocking accents with 3-D foam tape, as shown
Tip: Tuck them slightly under the branches.
7. Embellish with sparkles

Project 3: Make 4

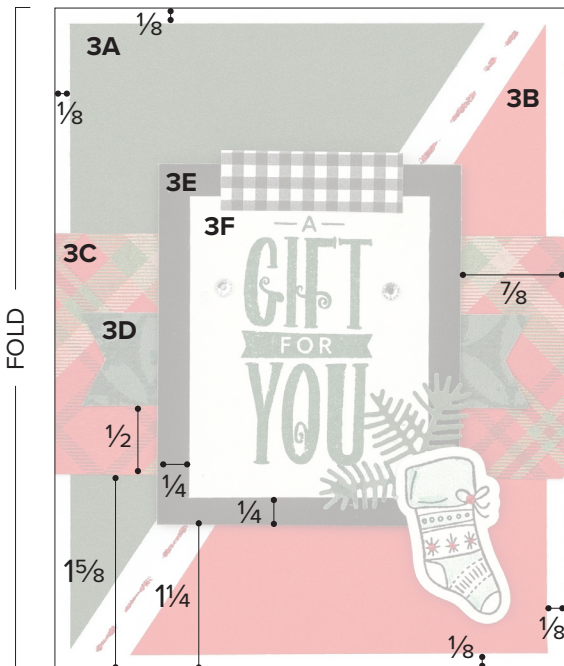
Prepare (4 each):



3F:
Paper: French Vanilla
Ink: Pine



P3 Accent:
Paper: French Vanilla
Ink: Intense Black
Tips: Color with colored pencil (Pine Green). Embellish with glitter glue and allow to dry.



Assemble:

1. Prepare pieces shown above
2. Attach 3A and 3B
3. Attach 3C
4. Dovetail and attach 3D, as shown
5. Attach 3E with 3-D foam tape
6. Attach prepared 3F
7. Attach prepared stocking accent with 3-D foam tape
Tip: Do not use adhesive along the top left corner so other pieces can be tucked behind it in a later step.
8. Attach P3 zip strip accent, as shown
9. Embellish with sparkles
10. Attach P3 sprig accents, as shown
Tip: Tuck these slightly behind the stocking accent.
11. Embellish with sparkles and glitter glue

Project 4: Make 4

Prepare (4 each):



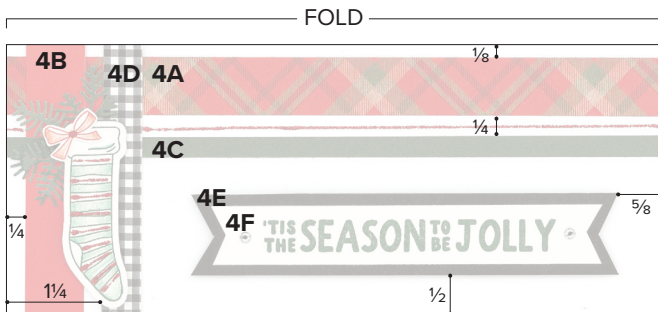

 Paper: French Vanilla
 Ink: Pine
 Tip: Dovetail.



P4 Accent:
 Paper: French Vanilla
 Ink: Pine
 Tip: Color with colored pencil (Pine Green). Embellish with glitter glue and allow to dry.



P4 Accent:
 Paper: French Vanilla
 Ink: Candy Apple
 Tip: Color with colored pencil (Fiery Red). Hand trim. Embellish with glitter glue and allow to dry.



Assemble:

1. Prepare pieces shown above
2. Attach 4A and 4B
3. Attach 4C and 4D
4. Attach prepared 4F to 4E, then dovetail 4E
5. Attach prepared 4E with 3-D foam tape
6. Attach prepared stocking accent with 3-D foam tape
Tip: Do not use adhesive along the top left corner so other pieces can be tucked behind it in a later step.
7. Attach P4 sprig accents, as shown
Tip: Tuck these slightly behind the stocking accent.
8. Attach prepared bow accent, as shown
9. Embellish with sparkles and glitter glue
Tip: Use a ruler as a guide for the glitter glue.
