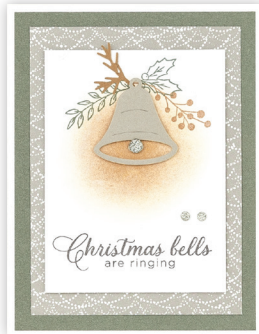


SILVER BELLS | 16 cards, 4 each of 4 designs

Featured Technique: Adding Color with a Blending Brush



Materials Needed:

- Z2831 Charcoal Exclusive Inks™ Stamp Pad
- Z6529 Rosemary Exclusive Inks™ Stamp Pad
- Z2828 Toffee Exclusive Inks™ Stamp Pad
- Z4575 Black LePen™
- Z2060 Thin 3-D Foam Tape
- Z4572 Blending Brushes
- Z5038 Die-cutting & Embossing Machine

- Y1000 1" x 1" My Acrylix® Block
- Y1003 2" x 2" My Acrylix® Block
- Y1005 1" x 6½" My Acrylix® Block
- Y1009 2" x 3½" My Acrylix® Block
- Paper Trimmer
- Scissors
- Adhesive
- Ruler

Getting Started:

- Gather all materials needed.
- Trim all zip strips and set aside. The zip strip is the 1/2" accent paper along the top of each sheet of patterned paper.
- Check the cut orientation below each cutting guide image. This will show you how to cut the paper, keeping the patterns on your project pieces facing the right direction.
- Light grey pieces on your cutting guide are project pieces. White pieces, not including labeled project pieces that must be die cut, are leftover paper.
- As you cut the paper, label and sort the pieces as indicated in the cutting guide, creating a stack for each project.
- In order to die-cut two shapes at once, place the die on top of two stacked paper pieces before running the paper through your die-cutting machine. Paper pieces that can be stacked for die-cutting will be labeled, "stack."

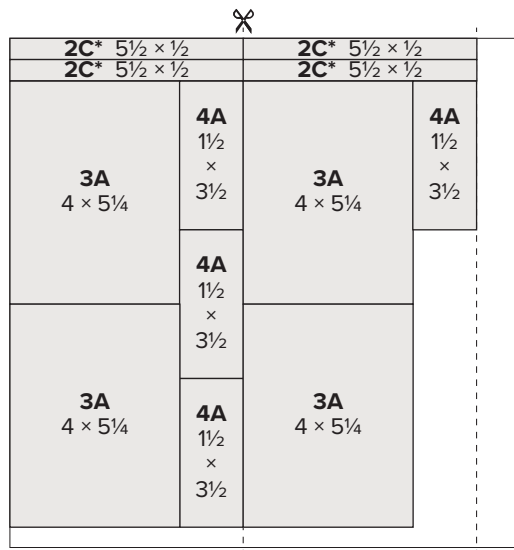
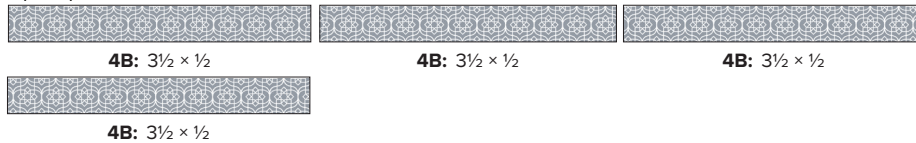

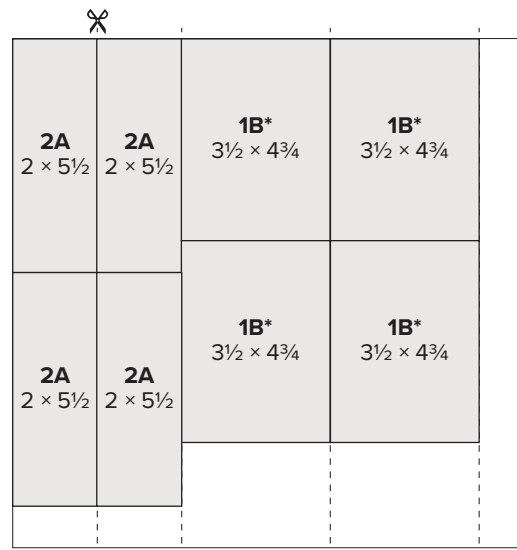
■ = suggested Thin Cuts arrangement

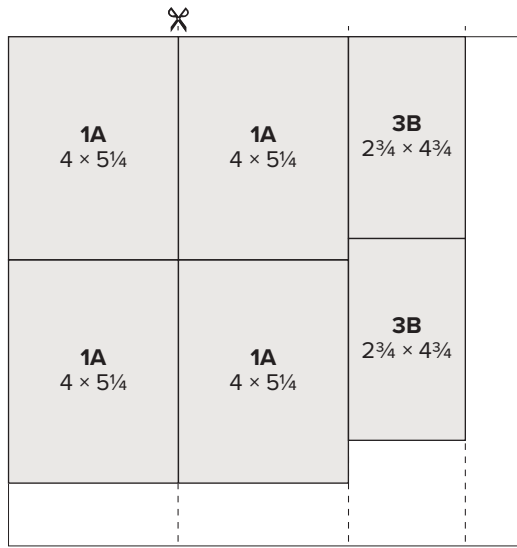


cut orientation

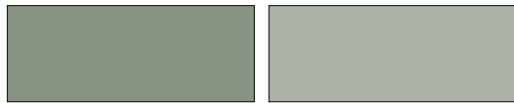

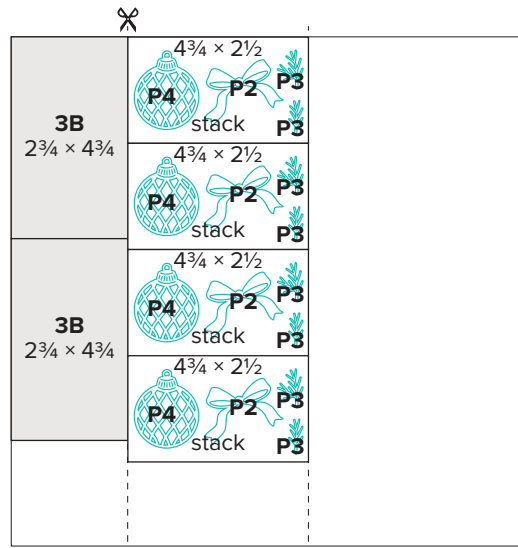


Rosemary cardstock

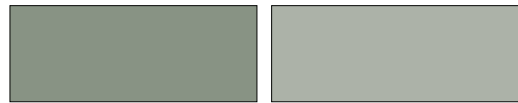

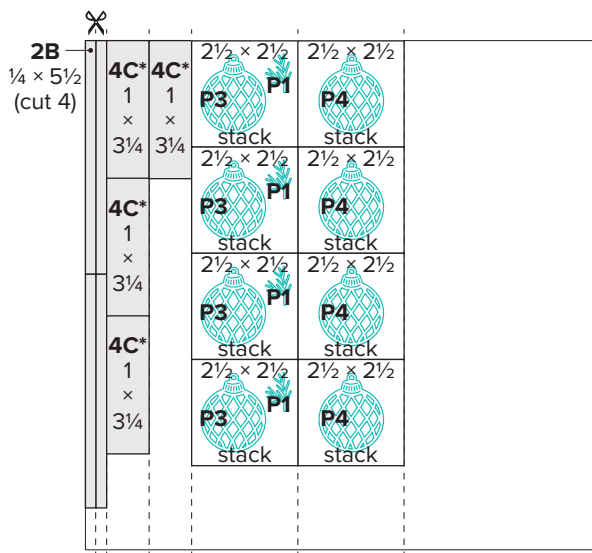


Rosemary cardstock

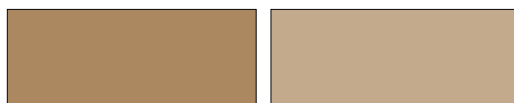

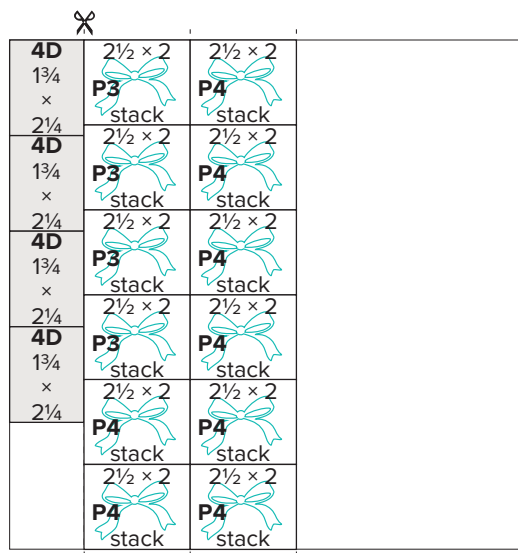
Toffee cardstock



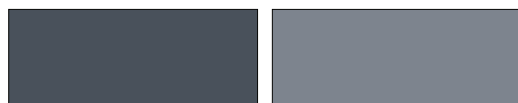

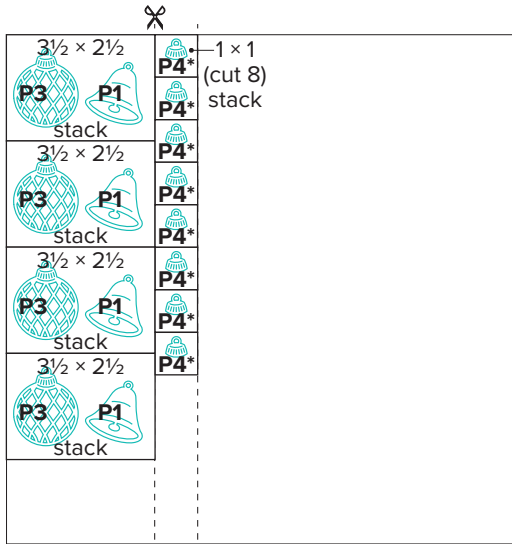
Charcoal cardstock

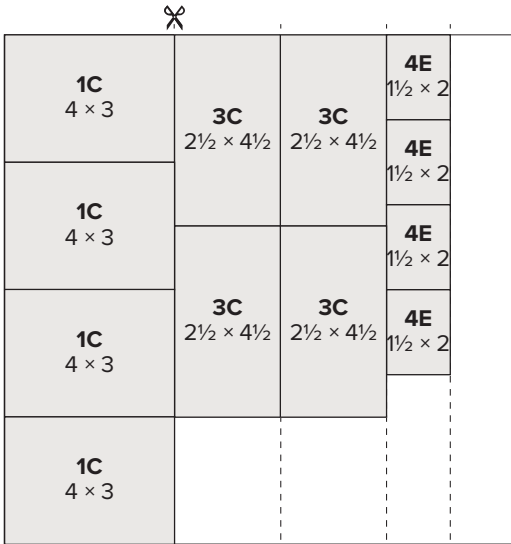
Mink cardstock

White Daisy cardstock

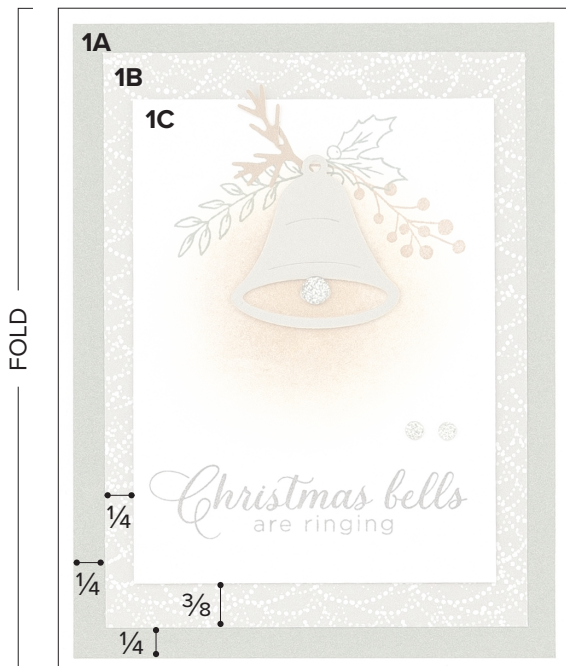


Project 1: Make 4

Prepare (4):



1C:
 Paper: White Daisy
 Inks: Charcoal, Rosemary, Toffee
 Tip: Create the background color with Toffee ink and a blending brush.
 Technique: Load the brush with ink by rubbing the bristles on the ink pad. Apply the ink to the cardstock using a gentle circular motion.

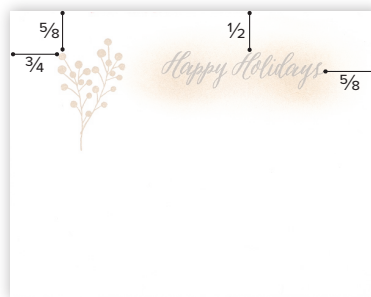


Assemble:

1. Prepare piece shown above
2. Attach 1A and 1B
3. Attach prepared 1C with thin 3-D foam tape
4. Attach P1 branch and bell die cut accents
Tip: Attach the bell with thin 3-D foam tape.
5. Embellish with the glitter gems

Project 2: Make 4

Prepare (4):



Card Base:

Inks: Charcoal, Toffee
 Tip: Create the sentiment's background color with Toffee ink and a blending brush.
 Technique: Load the brush with ink by rubbing the bristles on the ink pad. Apply the ink to the card base using a gentle circular motion.



Assemble:

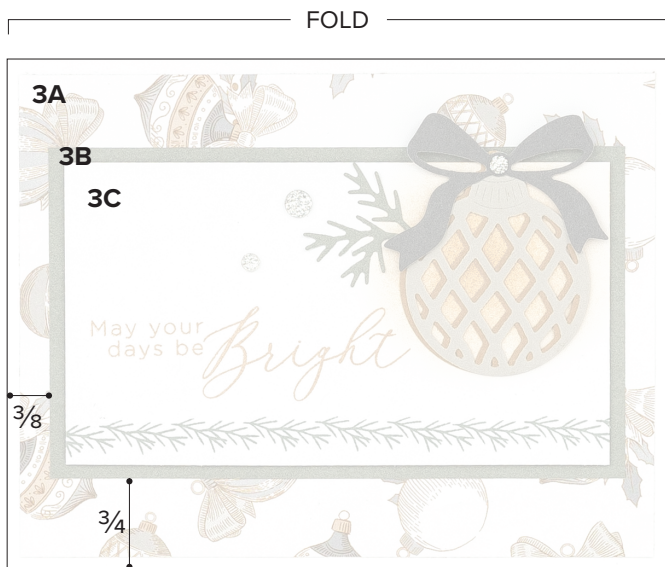
1. Prepare piece shown above
2. Attach 2A, 2B, and 2C
3. Attach P2 bow accent with thin 3-D foam tape, as shown
4. Embellish with glitter gems

Project 3: Make 4

Prepare (4):



3C:
 Paper: White Daisy
 Inks: Rosemary, Toffee
 Tip: Create the ornament's background color with Toffee ink and a blending brush.
 Technique: Load the brush with ink by rubbing the bristles on the ink pad. Apply the ink to the cardstock using a gentle circular motion.

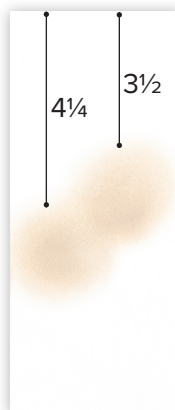


Assemble:

1. Prepare piece shown above
2. Attach 3A
3. Attach 3B
4. Attach prepared 3C with thin 3-D foam tape
5. Attach P3 ornament, branch, and bow die cut accents, as shown
Tip: Attach the Mink ornament to the Toffee ornament, slightly offset.
6. Embellish with glitter gems

Project 4: Make 4

Prepare (4 each):



Card Base:

Ink: Toffee

Tip: Create the ornaments' background color with Toffee ink and a blending brush.

Technique: Load the brush with ink by rubbing the bristles on the ink pad. Apply the ink to the cardstock using a gentle circular motion.

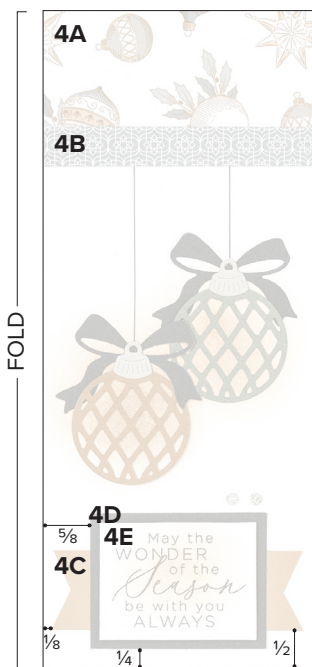


4E:

Paper: White Daisy

Inks: Charcoal, Toffee

Tip: Add color to the center with Toffee ink and a blending brush.



Assemble:

1. Prepare pieces shown above
2. Attach 4A and 4B
3. Dovetail and attach 4C, as shown
4. Attach 4D
5. Attach prepared 4E with thin 3-D foam tape
6. Attach P4 bow, ornament, and ornament top die cut accents, as shown
7. Draw string lines from ornaments to 4B with Black LePen™
8. Embellish with glitter gems
