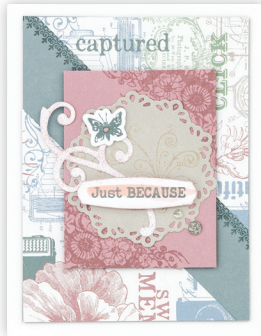


# SWEET MEMORIES | 16 cards, 4 each of 4 designs

## Featured Technique: Splattering with a Shimmer Brush and Sponging

## Getting Started:

- Gather all materials needed.
- Trim all zip strips and set aside. The zip strip is the 1/2" accent paper along the top of each sheet of patterned paper.
- Check the cut orientation below each cutting guide image. This will show you how to cut the paper, keeping the patterns on your project pieces facing the right direction.
- Light grey pieces on your cutting guide are project pieces. White pieces, not including labeled project pieces that must be die cut, are leftover paper.
- As you cut the paper, label and sort the pieces as indicated in the cutting guide, creating a stack for each project.
- In order to die-cut two shapes at once, place the die on top of two stacked paper pieces before running the paper through your die-cutting machine. Paper pieces that can be stacked for die-cutting will be labeled, "stack."

cut diagonal = angle in trimmer

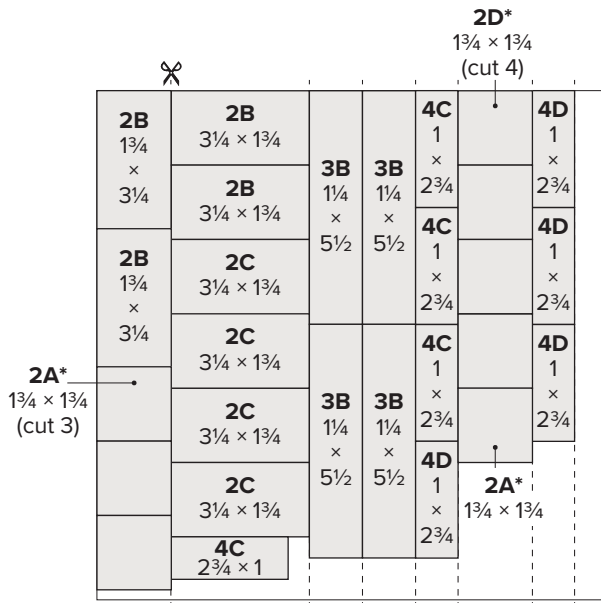
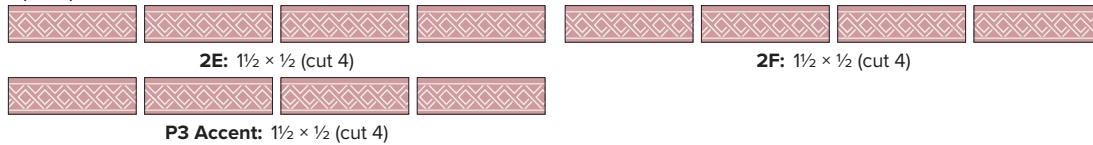

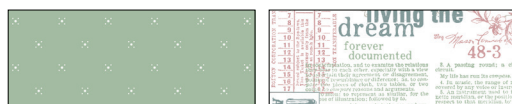

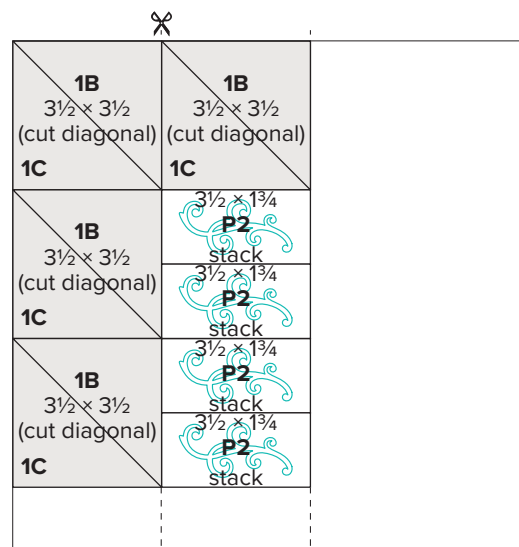


cut orientation

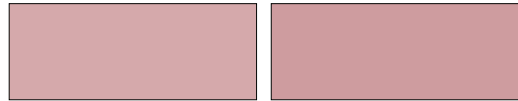

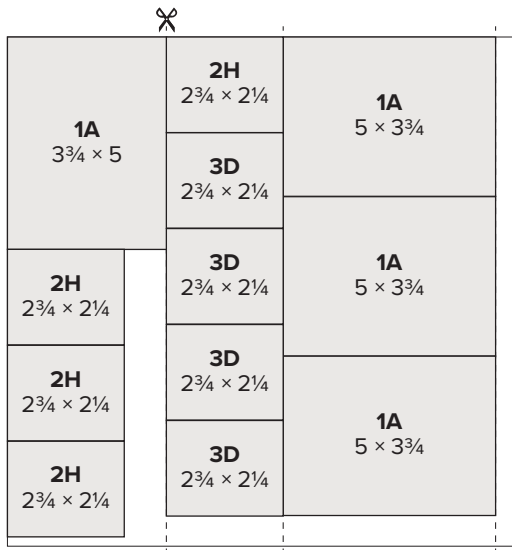
Mulberry cardstock

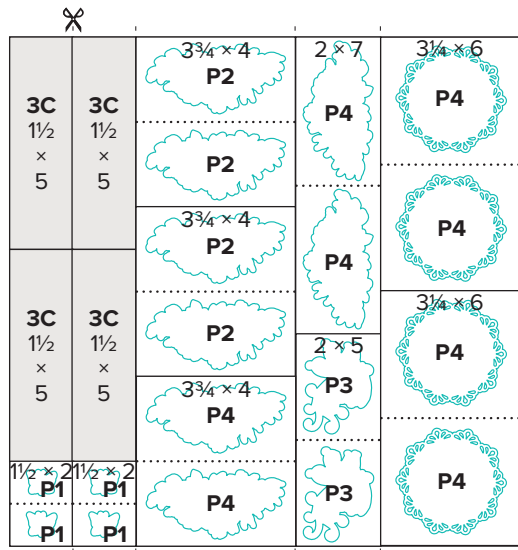


Mist cardstock

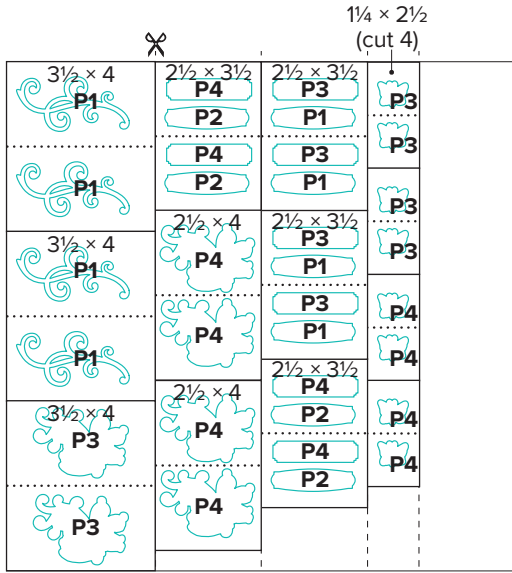

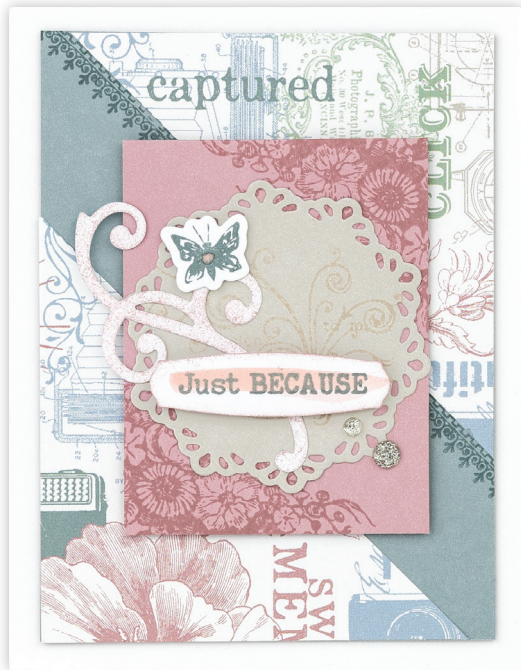

**Project 1: Make 4**

**Prepare (4 each):**



**1D:**  
Paper: light Mulberry  
Ink: Mulberry



**P1 Accent:**  
Paper: light Mink  
Ink: Mink



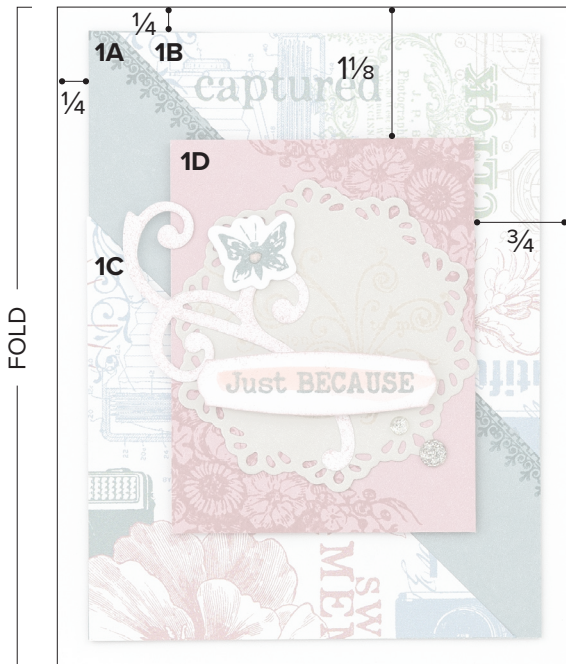
**P1 Accent:**  
Paper: White Daisy  
Inks: Mist, Mulberry  
Tips: Sponge the edges with Mulberry ink. Cut a wedge out of the round sponge and use it to apply the ink. Stamp the sentiment in Mist, then embellish with the Ballerina shimmer brush once the ink is dry.  
Technique: Gently rub the sponge on the ink pad and then lightly rub the edges of the cardstock until the desired amount of color is achieved.



**P1 Accent:**  
Paper: White Daisy  
Ink: Mulberry  
Tip: Sponge the cardstock with Mulberry ink.  
Technique: Gently rub the sponge on the ink pad and then lightly pounce it on the cardstock until the desired amount of color is achieved.



**P1 Accent:**  
Paper: White Daisy  
Ink: Mist  
Tip: Embellish with the Ballerina shimmer brush once the ink is dry.

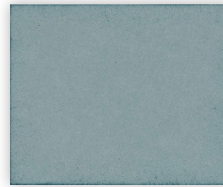


**Assemble:**

1. Prepare pieces shown above
2. Attach 1B and 1C to 1A
3. Stamp border on 1A with Mist ink  
*Tip: Use 1B as a guide.*
4. Attach prepared 1A with thin 3-D foam tape
5. Attach prepared 1D with 3-D foam tape
6. Attach prepared accents, as shown  
*Tip: Attach a few of these accents with foam tape for added dimension.*
7. Embellish with gems

**Project 2: Make 4**

**Prepare (4 each):**



**2H:**

Paper: light Mist  
Ink: Mist

Tip: Sponge the edges with Mist ink. Cut a wedge out of the round sponge and use it to apply the ink.

Technique: Gently rub the sponge on the ink pad and then lightly rub the edges of the cardstock until the desired amount of color is achieved.

**P2 Accent:**

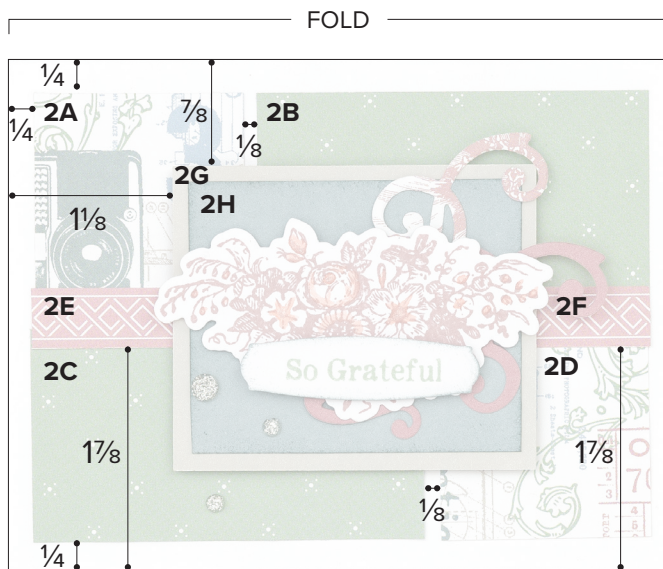
Paper: White Daisy  
Ink: Mulberry

Tip: Embellish with the Ballerina shimmer brush once the ink is dry.

Tips: Sponge the edges with Mist ink.



**Assemble:**

1. Prepare pieces shown above
2. Attach 2A, 2B, 2C, and 2D
3. Attach 2E and 2F
4. Attach 2G with 3-D foam tape
5. Attach prepared 2H
6. Attach flourish accents, as shown
7. Attach remaining prepared accents with thin 3-D foam tape
8. Embellish with gems

**Project 3: Make 4**

**Prepare (4 each):**



**3A:**  
Paper: light Mink  
Ink: Sage

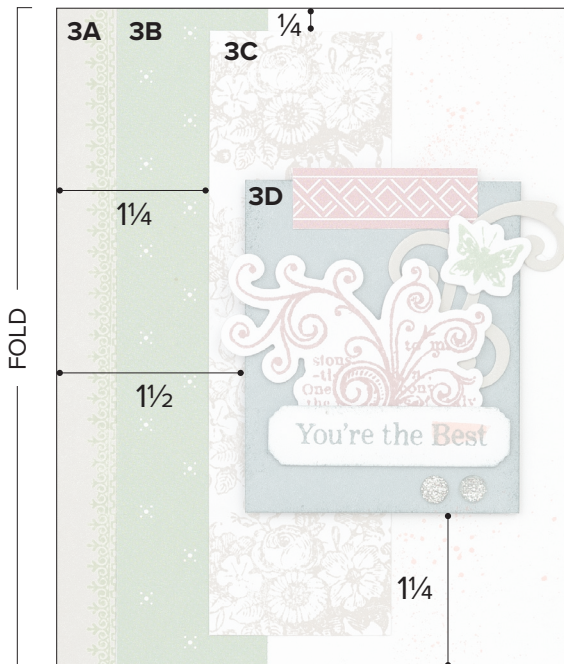
**3C:**  
Paper: White Daisy  
Ink: Mink

**3D:**  
Paper: light Mist  
Ink: Mist  
Tip: Sponge the edges with Mist ink. Cut a wedge out of the round sponge (or use the wedge from Project 2) and use it to apply the ink.  
Technique: Gently rub the sponge on the ink pad and then lightly rub the edges of the cardstock until the desired amount of color is achieved.

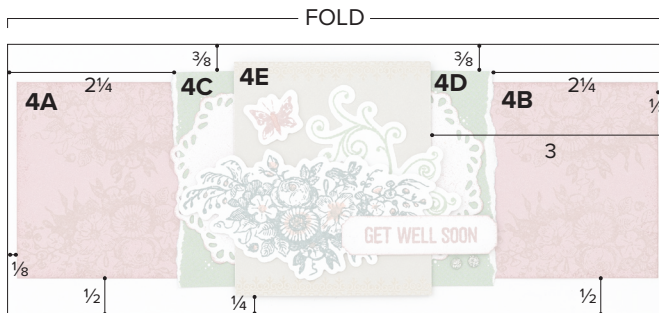
**P3 Accent:**

Tips: Sponge the edges with Mist ink. Embellish with the Ballerina shimmer brush once the ink is dry.



**Assemble:**

1. Prepare pieces shown above
2. Splatter card base with Ballerina shimmer brush  
*Technique: Squeeze the shimmer brush over an all-purpose mat to make a small puddle of ink. Pick up ink from the puddle with the tip of the brush, and gently tap the barrel of the brush on your index finger, above where you want the splatters to land.*
3. Attach prepared 3A and 3B
4. Attach prepared 3C
5. Attach prepared 3D with 3-D foam tape
6. Attach P3 zip strip accent, as shown
7. Attach light Mink flourish accent, as shown
8. Attach prepared accents with thin 3-D foam tape, as shown
9. Embellish with gems

## Project 4: Make 4



### Assemble:

1. Prepare pieces shown above
2. Attach prepared 4A and prepared 4B
3. Tear between  $\frac{1}{4}$ " to  $\frac{1}{2}$ " off one long edge of 4C and 4D, then attach
4. Attach prepared 4E with 3-D foam tape  
*Tip: Do not use adhesive along the left and right edges so other pieces can be tucked behind it in a later step.*
5. Attach prepared doily accents  
*Tip: Tuck these accents slightly behind 4E, as shown.*
6. Attach remaining prepared accents, as shown  
*Tip: Attach a few of these accents with thin 3-D foam tape for added dimension.*
7. Embellish with gems

### Prepare (4 each):



#### 4A and 4B:

Paper: light Mulberry  
Inks: Mink, Mulberry  
Tip: Sponge the edges with Mulberry ink, then stamp with Mink ink. Cut a wedge out of the round sponge (or use the wedge from Project 1) and use it to apply the ink.  
Technique: Gently rub the sponge on the ink pad and then lightly rub the edges of the cardstock until the desired amount of color is achieved.



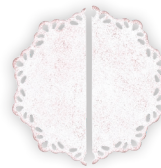
#### 4E:

Paper: light Mink  
Ink: Mink



#### P4 Accent:

Paper: White Daisy  
Ink: Mist  
Tip: Embellish with the Ballerina shimmer brush once the ink is dry.
